In the presentation, the individual questions or observations of all the evaluators that were thematised in the evaluations were thematically arranged, questions were answered and put in context. In addition to the debate on the suggestions and comments of the evaluators, several other questions or comments were raised: Professor L. Rabušic asked whether the curriculum of the evaluated study programmes included courses focusing on research methods. Vice-Dean P. Valouch asked what IT programmes proved successful in practice. V. Jankovic explained how English studies in Serbia are conducted. Professor P. Haiss asked if there is a graduate network within the degree programs. D. Šikolová asked if and how students are involved in research. Subsequently, the participants discussed the following topics, which were beyond the scope of the previous discussion: The promotion of study programmes, internationalisation, and student study trips abroad, the return on student surveys, and student feedback on taught courses.
