

Paper guidelines

Co-authors: size of co-authors shares of one author may not exceed 1.0

Extent of paper: not exceeding 7 pages (A4)

Title: not exceeding 100 characters

Annotation: 100 – 200 words (aim, methods, results),

Type: Times New Roman, size 11

Line: single, free line between paragraphs

Margin: 2.5 cm from all sides

Titles: do not use capital letters

Tables: tables have to be formatted as a text (not a picture)

Tables and figures: they have to contain title and source

Citations: written in brackets in the text (not footnotes)

Literature: all sources stated in the reference list have to be cited in the text

Maximum size of file: 1 MB

Formatting of reference list

All sources have to be formatted according to the examples stated below.

Reference list: arranged in alphabetical order

Surnames of authors – capital letters, separate by a comma.

Year of publishing – in brackets, behind authors.

Title of publication (monograph, journal, proceedings) – italics type.

State **ISBN**, **ISSN**, alternatively also **DOI** (if it is assigned).

Articles in journals: state volume, issue, page numbers and ISSN (and DOI).

List of literature should contain at least 3 sources indexed in Web of Science.

State the literature as shown:

Journal article

ISSN. DOI.

COOKE, P., PICCALUGA, A., (2006). *Regional development in the knowledge economy*. London and New York: Routledge Taylor & Francis Group. ISBN 0415578639.

Chapter in monograph

AUTHOR, A., AUTHOR, B., (year). Chapter title. In Editor, A., Editor, B. (eds.) *Monograph title*. Place: Publisher, pages (pp.). ISBN.

BOEKHOLT, P., JAGER, D., (2004). South-East Brabant: a regional innovation system in transition. In Cooke, P. N., Heidenreich, M., Braczyk, H. J. (eds.). *Regional Innovation Systems: The role of governance in a globalized world*. London: Routledge, pp. 44-62. ISBN 0-415-30369-9.

Article in conference proceedings
