

# Internationalisation for Lecturers

Are you interested in internationalising your teaching and classroom, online and/or live, and curious about how this is being done at other universities of applied sciences?

The Hague University of Applied Sciences organises a training trajectory for lecturers in joint collaboration with Amsterdam University of Applied Sciences and Rotterdam University of Applied Sciences.
