





The MUNI Innovation Award went to Vilém Pařil, Martin Šauer and Daniel Seidenglanz (in memoriam) from the Faculty of Economics and Administration, Using data on SIM card movements, they were able to find out how many people regularly travel between Prague, Brno, and Ostrava, Their research can be used, for example, by the Ministry of Transport or Czech Railways.
