- counts more than 800.000 volumes and offers study room for 400 students
- now works as a pick-up place and provides online services

- Scanned books usually available only on computers in the library are now accessible from anywhere via e-Loans



Facilities offered by MU

- **10 student residences** with a combined capacity of over 4,300 places (now limited capacity)
- **4 university cafeterias** offering meals for student prices (**Vinařská, the Rector’s Office, Faculty of Law, Campus**)+one pizzeria **Pizza Nostra** (Kounicova 507/50) – **Still open! Feel free to come and enjoy your meal. To-go-boxes available.**
- newly open the so-called “Veggie bar” at cafeteria at the Rector’s Office (on the 2nd floor), it offers self-service vegetarian and low-calorie dishes
- modern network of faculty libraries – **pick-up, online services**
- University Computer Centre open nonstop (Komenského nám.) – **now closed.**

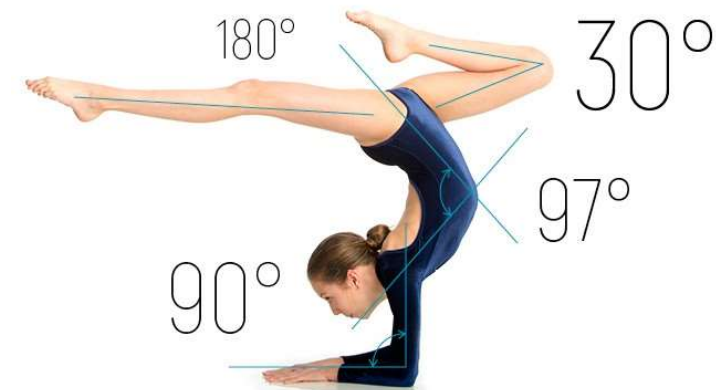

It is necessary to place the enrolment exception application in the Information System.

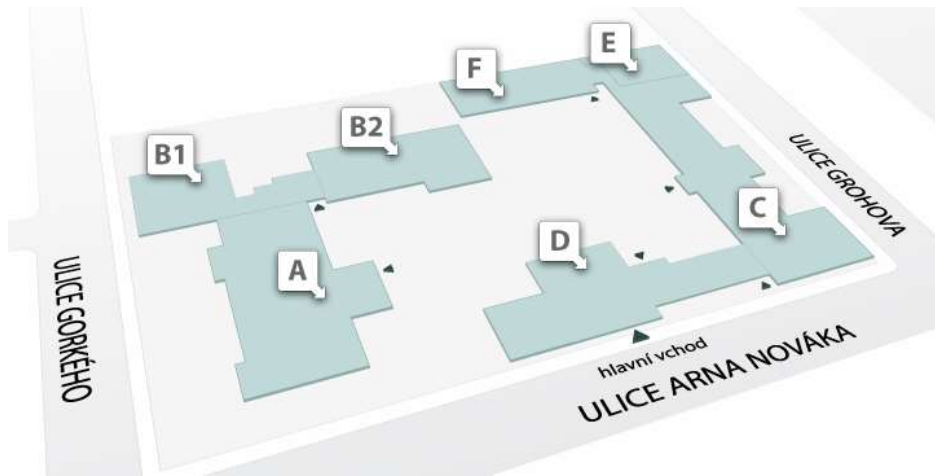

Arrival in the Czech Republic

Rules for entry and return to the Czechia (as of 5th February 2021)

for travels exceeding 12 hours

There are exceptions from these rules, particularly for the international transport and regular cross-border movement (cross-border workers, pupils and students, persons having rights of custody or rights of visitation).

¹ PES - anti-epidemic system of the Czech Republic

Green country - country with a low risk of COVID-19 transmission
Orange country - country with a medium risk of COVID-19 transmission
Red country - country with a high risk of COVID-19 transmission
Dark red country - country with a very high risk of COVID-19 transmission

Country that is not on the list of countries is considered as a country with a very high risk of COVID-19 transmission.

- If the Cash Office is closed we politely ask you to bring the exact amount



Register and enrol for courses in the IS (not valid for students of the Dept. of Czech For Foreigners) at is.muni.cz

- Select the appropriate semester (spring 2021)
- Send „Enrolment exception“ application (Žádost o výjimku) to be enrolled
- Attend the first class of the semester!

REMINDER – not applicable for the students of Dept. Czech for Foreigners

- Courses – students of MU are required to obtain at least 20 ECTS/semester
- Please enrol for courses at the department you are coming to; this should form at least 70% of the total amount of credits/semester
- Feel free to enrol for courses at other department/faculties – do not forget to attend the first class and to apply for „Enrolment exception“
- **Changes in Course enrolment can be made ONLY in the period of March 1st - 14th**

COMPLETION OF THE COURSE

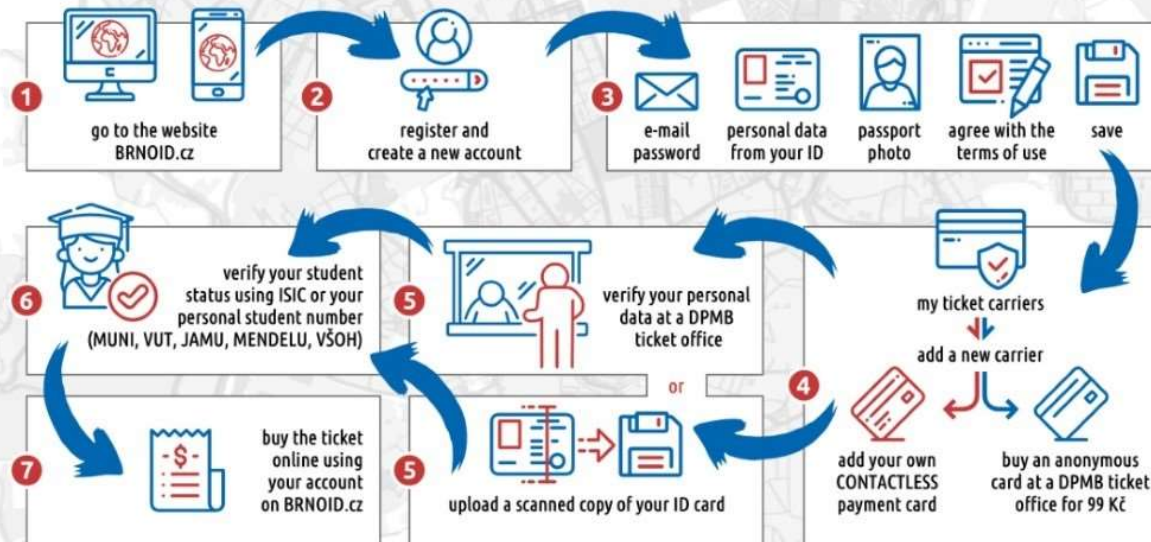
There are three options how you can complete your course:

- **Exam (zk.)** – A (excellent) – B – C – D – E – F (failed)
 - **Colloquium (k)** – P/N – passed / failed
 - **Credit (z)** – Z/N – credit / non-credit
- Some courses have more options of the evaluation and you can choose it on your own (for example exam or colloquium)
 - Please bear in mind that some forms of evaluation are not acceptable by your university
 - Ask at your home university, if the form of course completion is OK for them – some universities require score confirmation and our professors need to be informed about this in advance

Public Transport in Brno

- Tickets or transport passes (in Brno slang "šalinkarta") are valid for all the types of public transport
- For longer stays it is recommended to purchase a pass. Please, use the new system of electronic administration.

Public Transport in Brno

– **For purchasing a single ticket:**

– Use the BEEP & GO Contactless ticket purchase in a vehicle (<https://pipniajed.cz/en.html>)

– There are three steps to follow:

1. Get on / Have the card prepared before boarding the vehicle, so you don't cause a jam at the door.

2. Check in /

Tap your card against the reader every time you board a vehicle (even if you are only transferring).

3. Go! / Now you can just sit down and relax - you can be 100 % sure you have a valid ticket.

– ... and if your journey is shorter than fifteen minutes, there is one more step to follow:

4. Check out

– Short journeys under 15 minutes must be ended by a check-out, to let our system know it must charge you only the short-time ticket.

– Single tickets are also sold at ticket vending machines, viaSMS tickets, through mobile applications SEJF (www.sejf.cz), at DPMB shops, kiosks and railway stations (15-min ticket for 20 CZK, one hour ticket for 25 CZK).

Other important information

Mobile providers

There are 3 mobile providers in the Czech Republic:

- **T-Mobile**
- **O2**
- **Vodafone**
- You can also use the prepaid service of other providers such as **Kaktus** or **Tesco Mobile**.

If you become a member of ESN you will get free Vodafone SIM card with a special tariff for international students – 3 GB of data and unlimited SMS within the Vodafone network per month within a 50% discount for 6 months.

SUPO ACCOUNT

All university cards are connected with your virtual account at Masaryk University – your SUPO.

You can charge your SUPO account via Self-service top-up machine – in Czech "bankovník" in cash, or you can send the money via your bank account (but you can be charged a transfer fee). It is not possible to charge your SUPO account by using a credit card.

You charge your ISIC/temporary card with money in bankovník, and use this for copying, printing, etc.

To access your SUPO account, please go to **inet.muni.cz**.

Halls Rental information

You pay 2 deposits:

Booking deposit (2,000 CZK) – stays on the SUPO account

Accommodation deposit (amount of monthly halls rental, deposit for the last month)

Accommodation fee is payable in current month in the term, which is set in SUPO timetable

You have to pay within 10 days after your arrival.

BEFORE YOU LEAVE

- Please let us know **at least 3 days** before you leave Brno, so we have enough time to prepare your Transcript of Records – you can pick it up in our office
- If you have some money left on your SUPO account, you can pick it up in cash at the end of your stay at the faculty cash desk (building C, 2nd floor, Mon, Wed 9 – 12)
- In case you want to use Czech phone number and you sign a contract with a phone company, please make sure you have paid all the bills and the contract is ended before you leave. Otherwise you may be charged a high fine.

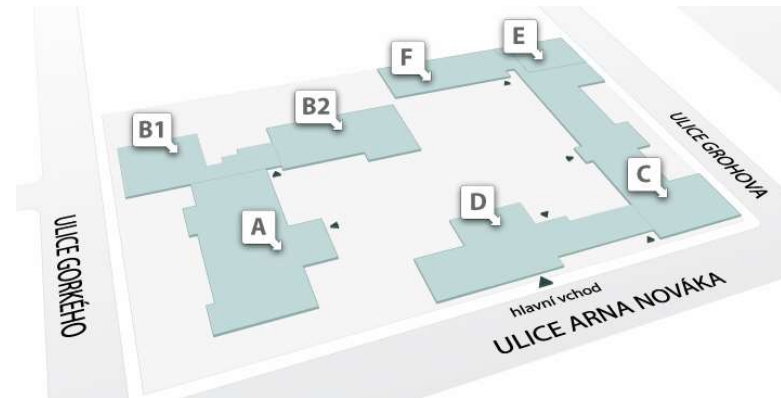
