License Conditions

Creators choose a set of conditions they wish to apply to their work.

Attribution (by)

All CC licenses require that others who use your work in any way must give you credit the way you request, but not in a way that suggests you endorse them or their use. If they want to use your work without giving you credit or for endorsement purposes, they must get your permission first.

ShareAlike (sa)

You let others copy, distribute, display, perform, and modify your work, as long as they distribute any modified work on the same terms. If they want to distribute modified works under other terms, they must get your permission first.

NonCommercial (nc)

You let others copy, distribute, display, perform, and (unless you have chosen NoDerivatives) modify and use your work for any purpose other than commercially unless they get your permission first.

NoDerivatives (nd)

You let others copy, distribute, display and perform only original copies of your work. If they want to modify your work, they must get your permission first.

[Lund University Libraries Head Office](#) will during the spring 2003 build a Directory of Open Access Journals to increase the visibility and ease of use of open access scientific journals. The project is funded by [Open Society Institute - Budapest](#) and also supported by [SPARC](#) (The Scholarly Publishing and Academic Resources Coalition).

The initial phase of this project involves creating a service that provides access to quality controlled journal level information about Open Access Journals. As well as providing search and browse facilities it will also provide a mechanism for user feedback and a means for suggesting additional journals to be included in the directory.

The second phase involves developing a search system for Open Access Journals on article level. A single point of access at document level would undoubtedly boost the use of the open access resources thus making a most wanted and valuable contribution to the necessary changes in the scholarly communication system.

DOAJ has migrated to a new, open source platform! Take a look around; we welcome your feedback.

You may notice that the number of journals in DOAJ has dropped from 10 027 to 9804. This is because we have fine-tuned the counting functionality. During the migration to the new platform, we identified a group of journals whose ISSNs have changed over time, e.g. because of a title change. We have introduced a 'continuation' relationship so that a previous ISSN entry is now correctly superseded by the new ISSN and the record counted once.





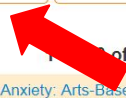

 One of the key discussions emerging from within the centre and centre-left of British politics is the means of combining a commitment to diversity with the aim of achieving social solidarity.
