


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#### What motivates you, personally?

#### Ten Commandments of Motivating Learners – Z. Dörnyei

- Set a personal example with your own behavior.
- 2 Create a pleasant, relaxed atmosphere in the classroom.
- 3 Present the tasks properly.
- 4 <u>Develop a good relationship with the learners</u>.
- Increase the learner's linguistic self-confidence.
- 6 <u>Make the classes interesting</u>.
- 7 Promote learner autonomy.
- 8 Personalize the learning process.
- Increase the learners' goal-orientedness.
