Grading

To pass the semester 2 practice presentation, students need to score sufficient grades for both the **language** part and the **structure/delivery** part.

<u>Language:</u> CEFR assessment of Range, Accuracy, Fluency, Coherence, Pronunciation. Please note that the minimum grade requirement for the language component of the presentation is a High C1 . **A lower grade is a fail.**

<u>Structure and Delivery</u>: Please note that the minimum grade requirement for the structure (50%) and delivery (50%) component of the presentation is an average of 5.5. **A lower grade is a fail.**

Students who fail one or both of the components will have to do a resit presentation. Although it is a practice presentation, students need to score the required pass levels.
