Giving reasons (cause and effect)

The thing that happened first (noun phrase)	Cause/Effect verb phrase	The thing that happened next (noun phrase)
<this action/process/thing>	produces	<this output>
<this action/process/thing>	causes	<this problem> / <this effect> / <this action>
<this action/process/thing>	results in	<this end result / effect>
<this action/process/thing>	leads to	<this result / effect>
<this action/process/thing>	brings about	<change / awareness / improvement / a revival / a new way of ...>

e.g. Getting angry in class (produces / causes / leads to / results in / brings about) ...

Pattern 2

Pattern 3
