INTERROGATIVE - Questions		
<b>Do</b>	I you	<b>work?</b>
<b>Does</b>	he she it	<b>work?</b>
<b>Do</b>	we you they	<b>work?</b>

Short answers:

**Do** I / you / we / they + **like** (base form of verb) chocolate?

Yes, I / you / we / they **DO**. No, I / you / we / they **DON'T**.

**Does** he / she / it + **like** chocolate?

Yes, he / she / it **DOES**. No, he / she / it **DOESN'T**.

(Do **NOT** reply **Yes, I like**. Or **Yes, I do like**.)
