Social media text:

Does an academic paper writing sound like a nightmare to you? Just follow these simple tips and become a confident writer.

First of all, be sure you are familiar with the required style of the paper. The structure and length is usually already given.

Brainstorm your ideas concerning the topic and organize them according to their importance.

Even if it seems illogical, we recommend you to start writing the main body following with the conclusion and the introduction in the very end. It helps you to stick with the main ideas.

During writing keep in mind to follow **these advices:**

- Be aware of the target audience
- Be concise and use precise terms
- Make your sentences clear and whole text coherent
- Be honest and avoid plagiarism
- Have your grammar checked

Formatting and editing should be done after you finished writing.

Extra tips: During whole writing process take inspiration from articles you like (style, vocabulary...) and don't be afraid to ask a critical friend for a feedback.

Academic text:

1) Introduction

Scientific writing is a science with rules. The process of creating an academic text can be differentiated into three phases: pre-writing phase, actual writing, editing and formatting.

2) Main body

Pre-writing phase

During the pre-writing phase it is advisable to get familiar with the guidelines setting the required style and basic standards of the text (i.e. structure, length, citation style etc.) as well as target reader.

In the next step, conduct brainstorming, by means of which the main ideas are gathered, organised according to importance and the final flow of ideas is set.

Actual writing

Academic text attributes are conciseness, precision, coherency and clarity. It is highly advised to focus on correct form and placement of citations to avoid plagiarism.

In the phase of actual writing, it is highly recommended to start with writing the main body following with the conclusion and the introduction in the very end. The conclusion and introduction are then formed according to the content of the main body.

During whole writing process take inspiration from articles you like (style, vocabulary...) and don't be afraid to ask a critical friend for a feedback.

Editing and formatting
