Abstract of the lecture

Presentation is focused on development of fiscal policy in the Czech Republic in the period 1993 - 2005. Theoretical characteristic of fiscal policy is briefly mentioned at the beginning of the lecture. Afterwards it is applied to development of the fiscal policy in the Czech Republic, which is divided into two main periods. The periods are separately analyzed. Present situation of the Czech Republic is compared with Masaryk's fiscal criteria at the end of the lecture.
