

REPORTED SPEECH

A TENSE CHANGES

Actual words -> **Report (indirect speech)**

„I **work** for IBM.“ -> She said she **worked** for IBM.

„I**m working** for IBM.“->She said she **was working** for IBM.

„I**ve worked** for IBM.“->She said she **had worked** for IBM.

„I**ve been working** for IBM.“ ->

She said she **had been working** for IBM.

„I **worked** for IBM.“

-> She said she **had worked** for IBM.

or

-> She said she **worked** for IBM.

„I **had worked** for IBM.“->She said she **had worked** for IBM.

„I**m going** to work for IBM.“

-> She said she **was going** to work for IBM.

„I **can / will / may** work for IBM.“

-> She said she **could / would / might** work for IBM.

- *There is no change for might, could, should, would.*

B PEOPLE, PLACES, TIMES AND THINGS

PEOPLE

I	->	HE / SHE
YOU	->	ME
MY	->	HIS / HER
YOUR	->	MY

PLACES

HERE	->	THERE, AT THE OFFICE
------	----	----------------------

TIMES

NOW	->	THEN, AT THE TIME
TODAY	->	THAT DAY, ON MONDAY
YESTERDAY	->	THE DAY BEFORE, THE PREVIOUS DAY
TOMORROW	->	THE NEXT DAY, THE FOLLOWING DAY
THIS AFTERNOON	->	THAT AFTERNOON
LAST WEEK	->	THE WEEK BEFORE, THE PREVIOUS WEEK
NEXT WEEK	->	THE WEEK AFTER, THE FOLLOWING WEEK
A FEW DAYS AGO	->	A FEW DAYS BEFORE, A FEW DAYS EARLIER

THINGS

THIS PROJECT	->	THE PROJECT
--------------	----	-------------

*I'll see **you here tomorrow**, said Sue.
Sue said **she'd see me there the next day**.*

*I've read **your** report about **this** project, he said.
He said **he'd read my** report about **the** project.*

C NO TENSE CHANGE

- We do not need to change tense if the information is still true.

The sales team are doing very well at the moment.

He says / said the team are doing very well.

- We do not need to change tense if we report something which is always true.

There is always a period of uncertainty after a merger.

He says / said there is always a period of uncertainty after a merger.

D REPORTING QUESTIONS

Where is it? ->He asked me where it was.

Do you speak French?
-> She asked me if/whether I spoke French.

- *The **word order** in reported questions is like a normal statement.*

E REPORTING COMMANDS

Take us to the airport.
->She **told the driver to take** us to the airport.

Don't worry. I'll deal with it.
->She **told me not to worry**.
