## A TENSE CHANGES

# <u>Actual words -> Report (indirect speech)</u>

"I work for IBM." -> She said she worked for IBM. "I`m working for IBM."->She said she was working for IBM. "I`ve worked for IBM."->She said she had worked for IBM.

"I've been working for IBM." -> She said she **had been working** for IBM.

"I worked for IBM."

-> She said she **had worked** for IBM.

or

-> She said she **worked** for IBM.

"I **had worked** for IBM."->She said she **had worked** for IBM. "I'**m going** to work for IBM."

-> She said she **was going** to work for IBM.

"I can / will / may work for IBM."

-> She said she **could / would / might** work for IBM.

• There is no change for might, could, should, would.

## C NO TENSE CHANGE

• We do not need to change tense if the information is <u>still</u> <u>true</u>.

The sales team are doing very well at the moment. He says / said the team are doing very well.

• We do not need to change tense if we report something which <u>is always true</u>.

There is always a period of uncertainty after a merger. He says / said there is always a period of uncertainty after a merger.

## D REPORTING QUESTIONS

<u>Where</u> is it? ->He asked me <u>where</u> it was.

Do you speak French?

-> She asked me <u>if/whether</u> **I spoke** French.

• The word order in reported questions is like a normal statement.

## E REPORTING COMMANDS

Take us to the airport. ->She **told the driver to take** us to the airport.

Don't worry. I'll deal with it. ->She **told me not to worry**.
