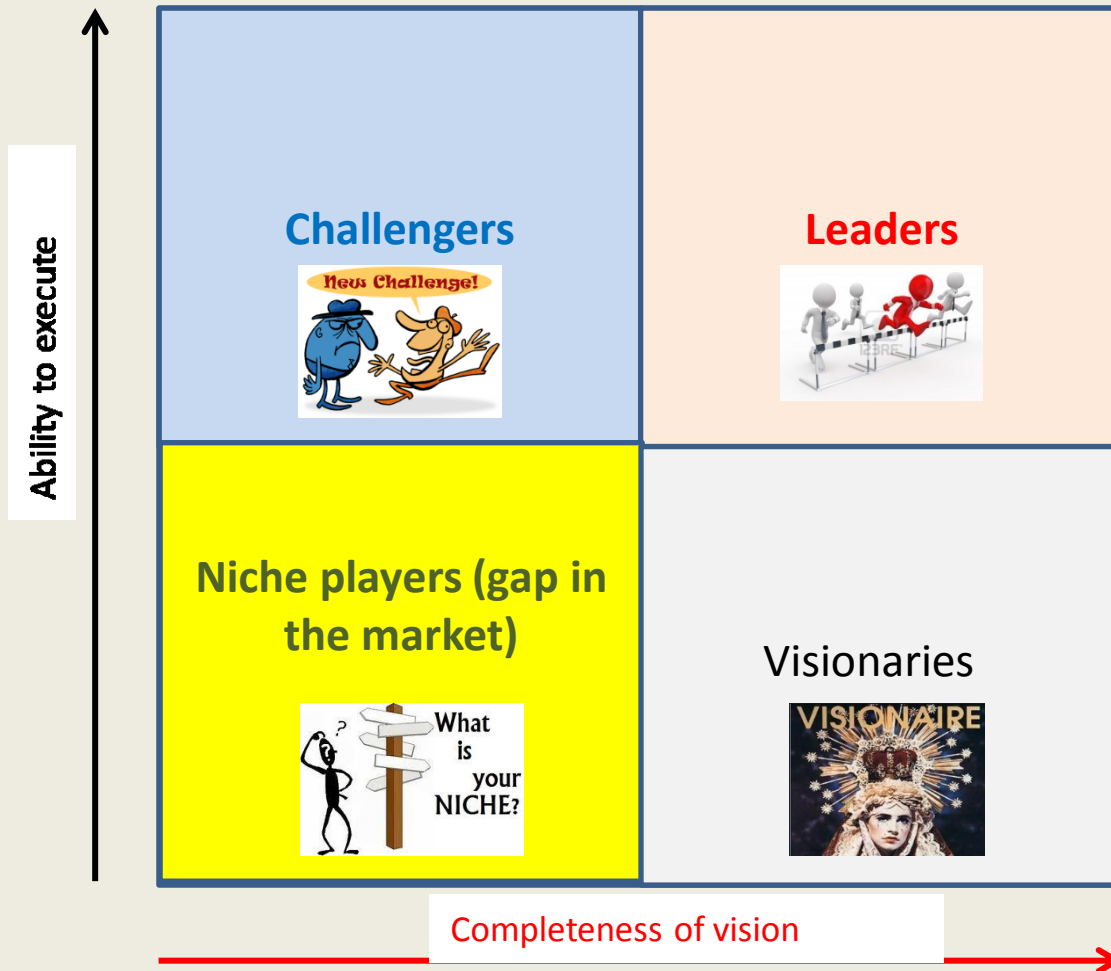

MQ Matrix

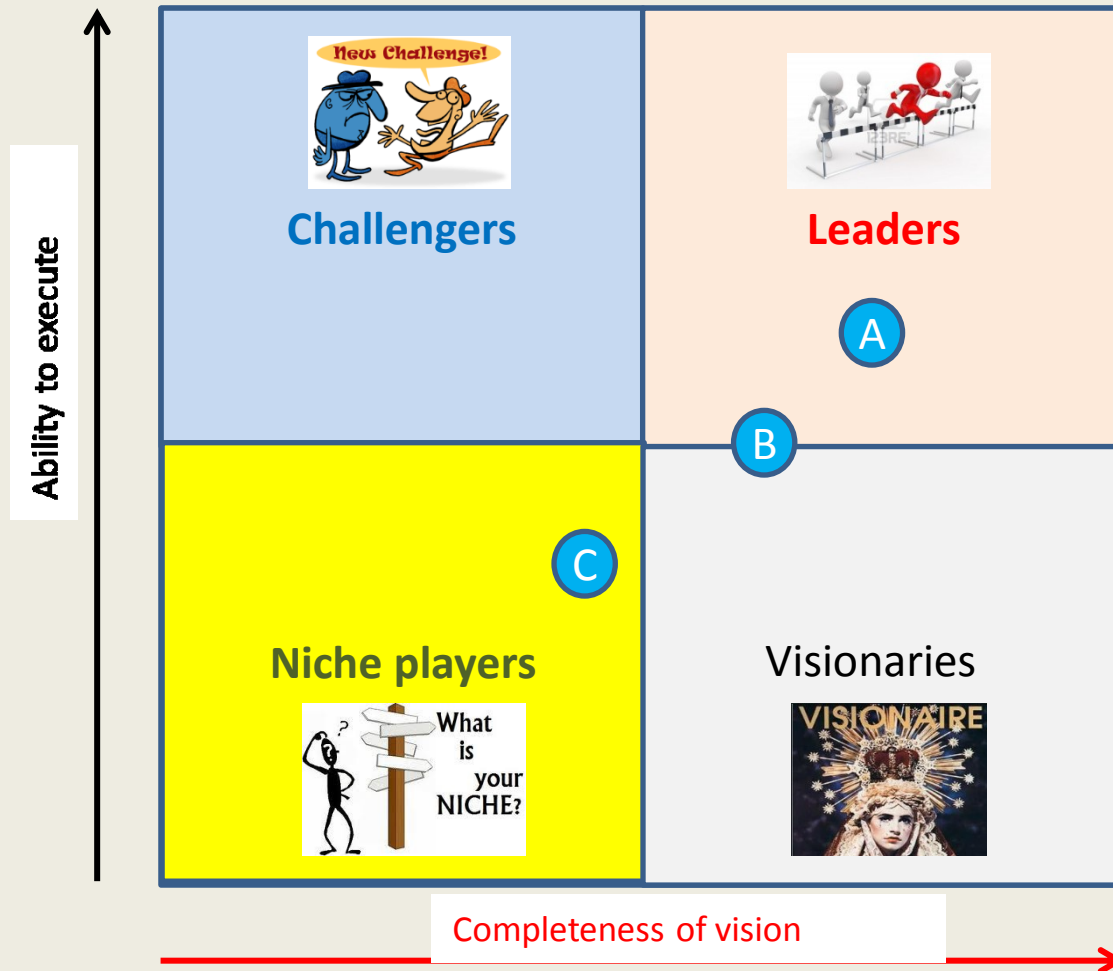


MQ Matrix explanation

- **Leaders** execute well against their current vision and are well positioned for tomorrow.
- **Visionaries** understand where the market is going or have a vision for changing market rules, but do not yet execute well.
- **Niche Players** focus successfully on a small segment, or are unfocused and do not out-innovate or outperform others
- **Challengers** execute well today or may dominate a large segment, but do not demonstrate an understanding of market direction.

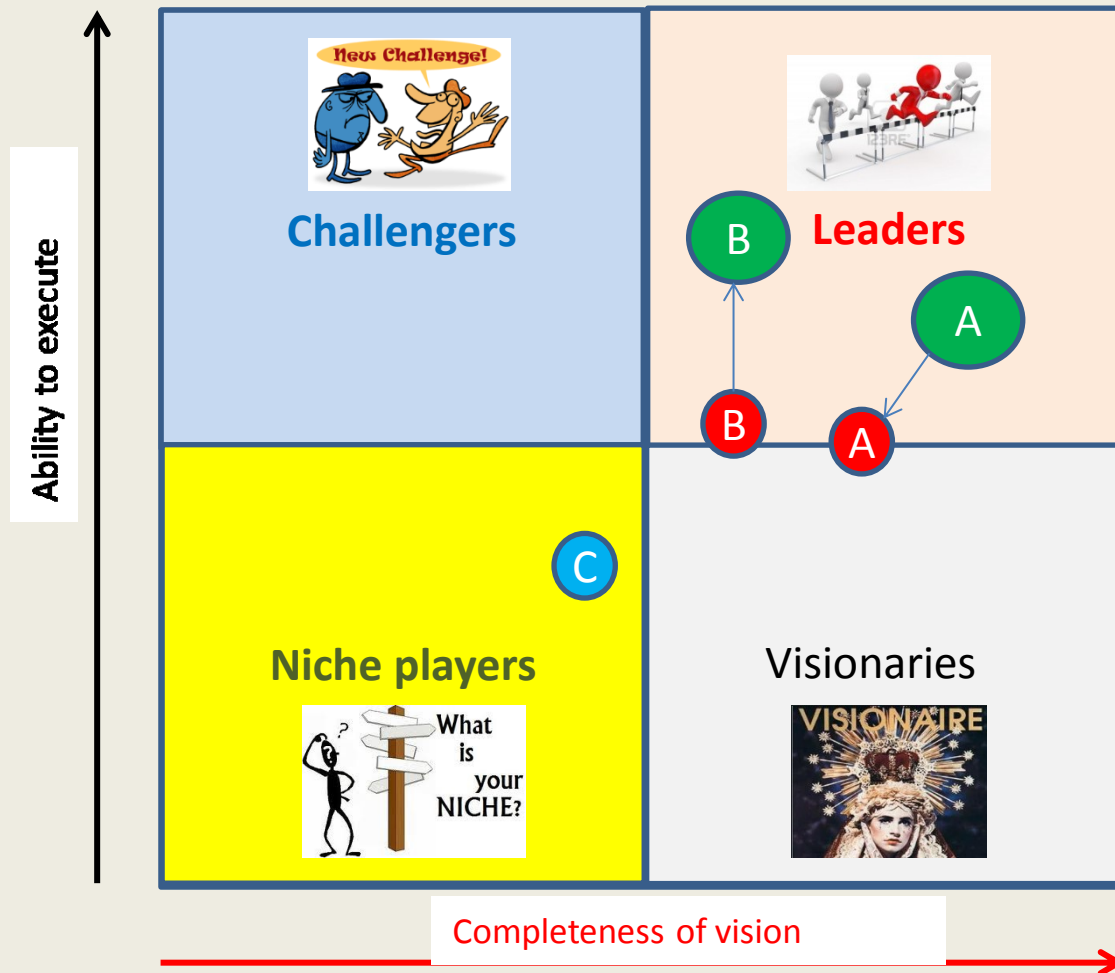

„A“ better than „B“ and „B“ Better than „C“



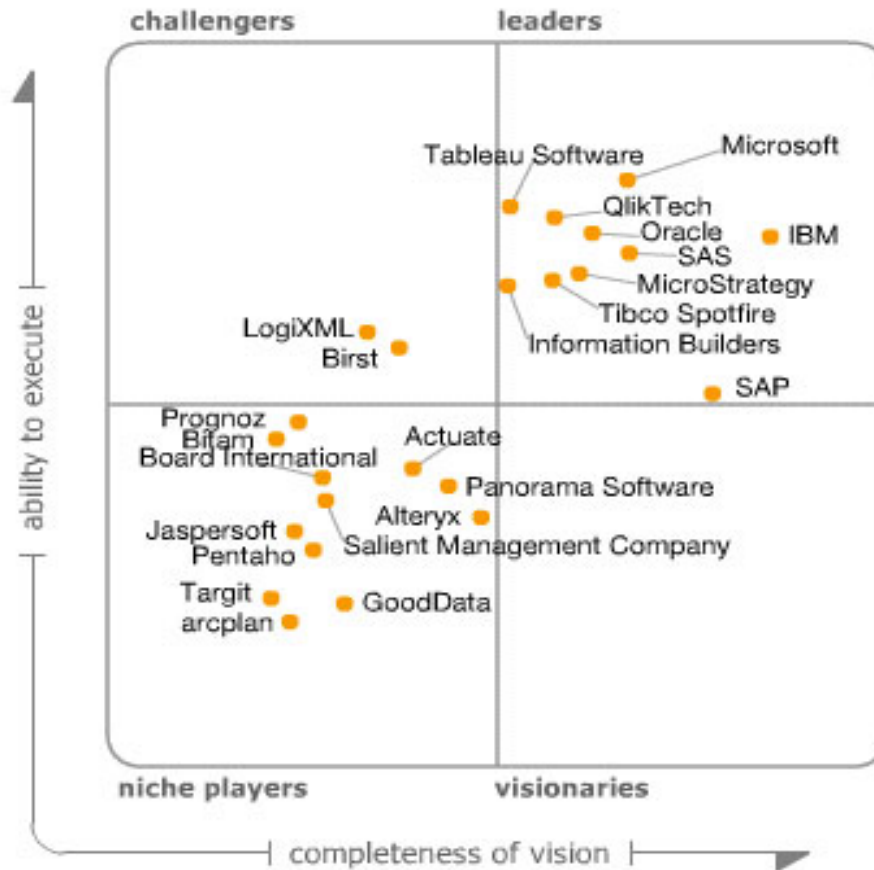

Using colors in order to show progress (Red = bad, Green = good)



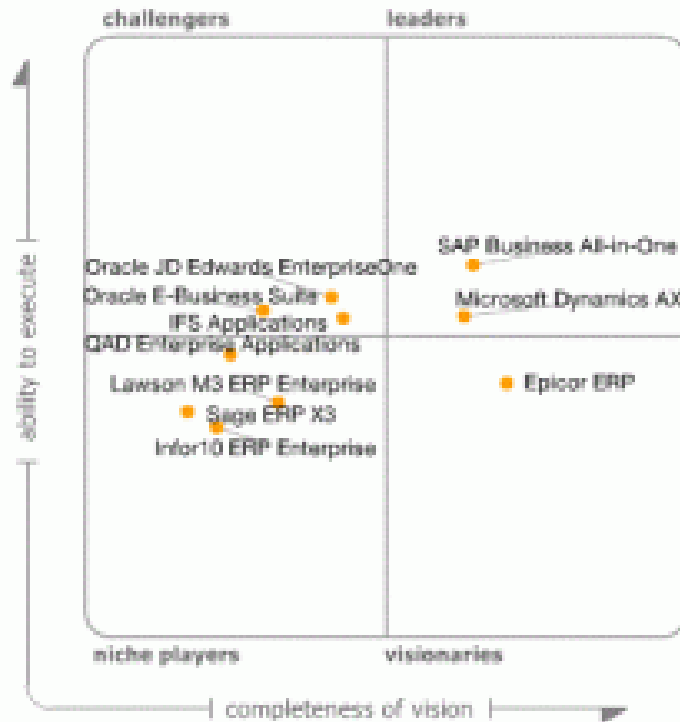
