In 1 latest example of 2 Japan seizing upon 3 Western idea, adapting it to 4 culture and improving upon it, 5 Japanese computer users have evolved 6 unique set of emoticons. 7 Japanese smileys are intricate in 8 design, somewhat ambiguous in 9 expression and, in what many here would argue is 10 big advance, are right side up instead of sideways.

..... 11 basic smiley in Japan, (^_^), is much easier to recognize as 12 face than 13 Western version. But

since 14 mouth doesn't curve upward (no character on 15 keyboard can do that), 16 Japanese smiley is somewhat harder to understand without knowing 17 context.

Other emoticons are more clearly specific to Japanese culture: 18 woman's smile, (^.^), with 19 dot for 20 mouth, because it is still considered impolite for 21 women to bare 22 teeth in 23 grin, to 24 extent that some women still cover 25 mouths with 26 hand when they laugh.
