So you have to ask yourself: Is the project feasible? Will it add value?

One way to get the answers is by preparing a project ovewiew, or project charter, which lays out the purpose and the strategy behind the project.

When planning, you have to a lot of things - allocate resources, forecast costs, prepare a budget and time schedule, and evaluate the risk factor

Equally important is selecting the project team.

Executing should be relatively easy, especially if you have thought through the potential problems and developed contingency plans if things go wrong.

You should be able to deliver the project on time and within the specifications.
