

THE STRATEGY OF PROFESSIONALISM

The pursuit of CSOs sustainability Ideal: employment professionalization

- The Ideology of professionalism versus
- Romantic ideal of CSOs = the base for CSOs´ critics argumentation
 - populists and extremists

THE IMPACT OF "EMPLOYMENT PROFESSIONALISM"

Formation of the group of "expert citizens" = CS avant-garde

Domestication of CSOs in the public policy institutions

Commercialization of CSOs

THE PROFESIONALISM STRATEGY IMPACT

Transactional activism + formation professionalized service CSOs with minimum membership

Decline of:

- empathy
- enthusiasm

..events triggered by small advocacy organisations that are characterised by a small membership and are therefore unable to mobilise large numbers of supporters. However, they do generate a significant number of such events and are able to work well with similar and network with them. Unlike the old participatory activism, which focused on the economic interests of its members, the new transactional activism focuses on the post-materialist claims...

- public mobilization competences

Two-speed CS: "turbo a mañana CSOs"

THE PROFESSIONALIZED CSOs and GENERAL PUBLIC

- The fall of membership importance = citizen´s uprooting from the CSOs
- Bureaucratization and specialization for the needs of donors
- Loss of sectoral identity = CSOs are viewed as extended hand of state or donors

CSOs AND DEMOCRACY DECLINE

Alexis de Tocqueville: Associations / CSOs are schools of democracy:

- Citizenship education
- Socialization into the role of citizens
- Without CSOs the modern democracy is impossible

THE PROBLEM: The fall of membership = loss of pupils!!!


The Onset of Populism!

- Illiberal Turn in the Czech Politics
- Society Division on the two camps:
- 1. anti-elitists (leader democracy)
- 2. anti-populists (liberal democracy)

POPULISM AND CIVIL SOCIETY

Populists refuse partnership and mediating role of CSOs in society = negative image!

Power Sandwich?



Populists define the power structure by the relationship between the leader and his followers!

The attribute of populism is anti-elitism!

And CSOs representatives are part of cultural elite!

THE IMPACT ON CIVIL SOCIETY

The changes in civil society structure:

- I. LIBERAL ("TRUE") CS= transparent, prodemocratic, service and advocacy CSOs
- II. UN-CIVIL CS = populistic, nationalistic and extremist political movements
- III. PARASITIC CS = hidden informal networks, clientelistic or corrupt character

PROFESSIONALISM IN CIVIL SOCIETY AND THE WEAKENING OF LIBERAL DEMOCRACY

"CSOs members are less prone to vote for populistic parties." (Boeri 2019)
