

PB138 — Pattern based schemata

Schematron

- Schema language based on **patterns** instead of **grammar**
- Suitable for more "relaxed" markups, where it is enough to specify the schema only "roughly" by setting some rules, not exact grammar exhaustively

Examplotron

- Examplotron was an experiment to define markup model by just giving **example(s) of valid document(s)**
- The "example document" is converted to a RelaxNG schema and then the normal RelaxNG validation can be done.
- Not widely used but simple to use with no major obstacles.
