
## Borrowing Books in Library

Description: The process represents ordering books at the library. The reader asks to create an order. He chooses available titles from available books (library fund). When he selects the books, the system checks to see if the reader has any overdue books. If a reader has some overdue books, he cannot create a new book order. The system further checks whether the reader has a valid membership. The membership must be valid for another 30 days from the date of borrowing books. Payment is in progress, membership is re-verified if successful. If payment does not pass, the order is being closed. After membership verification, an order is created. The librarian will then prepare the books for picking up. The reader receives a message notification when his books are ready. When taking books, the reader is asked to prove his identity with an identity card; if he proves, he will receive the books. If it is not proven, the order will be cancelled.
