Gorkého 46, Brno–střed

The toll of Fast fashion

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

The environmental impact of fast fashion is substantial. The industry's rapid production cycles contribute to increased greenhouse gas emissions, mainly from energy-intensive manufacturing processes and transportation.

The massive water consumption for dyeing fabrics and finishing garments further strains global water resources. Moreover, the disposal of vast quantities of unsold or discarded clothing adds to the environmental burden, as textiles in landfills can take centuries to decompose, releasing pollutants.

92 MILLIONS TONS OF WASTE

We discard 92 million tons of clothes-related waste each year

The waste generated by fast fashion poses significant environmental challenges. The industry's "throwaway culture" encourages consumers to quickly

discard clothing items, contributing to an alarming accumulation of textile waste. The fabrics used in fast fashion often take a considerable amount of time to decompose in landfills, releasing harmful pollutants into the soil and water.

WATER AND AIR POLLUTION

Fast fashion generates more CO₂ than aviation and shipping combined

Fast fashion is a major contributor to environmental pollution across various stages of its lifecycle. The production process involves intensive chemical use, from dyeing fabrics to finishing garments. The widespread use of synthetic materials, such as polyester, further compounds the issue, as these materials release microplastics and harmful chemicals into the environment, particularly during washing.

UNSUSTAINABLE LIFESTYLE

The fast fashion lifestyle is inherently unsustainable due to its emphasis on rapid, disposable consumption. Characterized by quick production cycles, mass manufacturing, and frequent style turnover, this model encourages a culture of overconsumption. Consumers are enticed to continuously purchase inexpensive, trendy items, often worn briefly before being discarded. This cycle not only generates immense textile waste but also fuels resource depletion.



Fast fashion, the pervasive industry that brings runway trends to retail shelves in record time, has woven a web of consequences that extend far beyond our overflowing closets.

The incessant demand for new styles results in resource-intensive manufacturing processes, contributing to water pollution and excessive energy consumption. Moreover, the industry often relies on exploitative labor practices in low-wage countries, where workers endure substandard conditions and meager wages.



ETHICAL IMPLICATIONS

Beyond the glossy storefronts and runway shows lie the harsh realities faced by garment workers in the fast fashion industry. The ethical implications of fast fashion are deeply concerning, rooted in exploitative practices that compromise human rights and dignity. The industry's relentless pursuit of low production costs often leads to the exploitation of workers in developing countries, where labor regulations may be lax. Employees frequently face substandard working conditions, long hours, and inadequate wages, violating fundamental human rights.

Lastly, thrift shopping aligns with the principles of the circular economy, emphasizing the reuse and recycling of products. Clothing items are circulated through different owners, extending their lifecycle and reducing the need for new production.

12 Homeless Vintage

Operating without state aid, the non-profit sells a portion of the clothing in thrift stores to cover operational costs.
