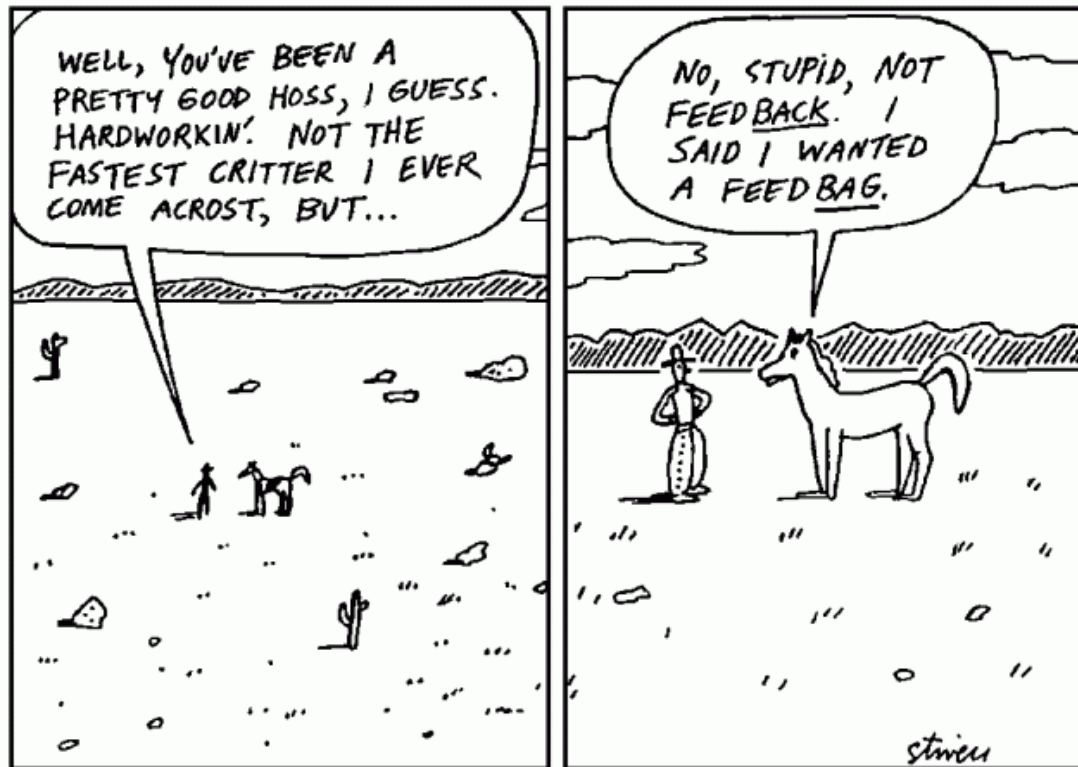

# Feedback



## What is feedback and how to provide it

- Feedback **is not** about correcting mistakes and editing
- Feedback **is** providing **guidance**
- See what the positive and negative features of your fellow student's work are
- Focus only on several key areas
- Start with a positive point and keep your comments balanced
- Be encouraging

In your comments consider the following aspects

- **Content** (Do you understand the message of the letter?)
- **Structure** (clear, logical, linking words, ...)
- **Style** (appropriate, formal, ...)
- **Vocabulary** (range, accuracy, collocations, ...)
- **Grammar** (range, accuracy – especially word order)
