- 1. Organisation**
 - title
 - introduction
 - main body (key points, logical sequence, sign-posting language)
 - ending (conclusion)
 - closure
 - timing

- 2. Content**
 - topic coverage
 - relevant to academic audience
 - informative
 - understandable
 - interesting, entertaining

- 3. Language**
 - appropriate to audience
 - explanation of jargon
 - voice (speed, volume, clarity, intonation)
 - grammatical accuracy
 - correct pronunciation of key words

- 4. Body language**
 - eye contact
 - use of notes
 - stance, enthusiasm

- 5. Visuals**
 - appropriate
 - supportive
 - clear

- 6. Questions**
 - handling of the discussion
 - clear, appropriate responses

- 7. Complex impression** – the best feature/part/characteristics
 - one feature that should be changed/avoided/improved
