**Ointments** are greasier than creams and have a thicker texture. This makes them adhere to the affected area longer. **Creams** are more acceptable cosmetically and tend to be used on the face as they are less visible. **Pastes** are stiffer preparations which contain more powdered solids. **Lotions** are liquid and used in areas such as the scalp where an ointment or cream would adhere to the hair.
