1/ The Airline Coding Directory, which is published by the IATA annually and involves the list of two-digit and three-letter airline codes, is a complex and detailed manual for everybody working in air travel business.

2/ The IATA database is displayed on-line and contains important statistic data enabling airline companies to compare their results to the results of many other similar and successful airline companies.

3/ In the near future the IATA is planning to improve some of their services to decrease the number of mishandled baggage and to introduce self-service check-in stalls.

4/ The Chicago convention regulated the responsibility of air travel companies for passengers' death and injury and for loss of or damage to baggage.

5/ In 2004 the WTO included 140 countries and 300 affiliate members from the private sector, educational institutions and tourism associations and authorities.

6/ The very beginning of WTO dates back to 1925 when it was set up in Naples.

7/ The WTO got its present name in 1970 and its headquarters moved to Paris.

8/ The WTO has six regional commissions representing particular parts of the world as followed: Africa, North America and Europe, Southern America and the Pacific, East Asia, the Middle East, South Asia.
