Algia,ale, F : myalgia /maɪ'ældʒiə, -dʒə/—muscular pain, neuralgia - /njʊ'rældʒə/ pain in the distribution of a nerve or nerves

Analgesia /,æn(ə)'dʒi:ziə/ - insensibility to pain, hyperalgesia /haɪpə,ræ'l'dʒi:zə/- an abnormally increased sensitivity to pain

Agra,ae,F : podagra – gout

Aesthesia, ae, F – , perception, sensation Dysaesthesia /,dɪsɪs'θi:ziə/ - abnormal sensation

Odynia,ae, F: achillodynia – pain in heel/ Achilles /ə,kɪli:z/ tendon

Dolor,oris, M : dolores post operationem

Dolorosus,-a,-um – painful

Dolens, -entis – painful
