OVERALL SPOKEN PRODUCTION	Can reasonably fluently sustain a straightforward description within his/her field of interest.	Can give clear, systematically developed descriptions, with appropriate highlighting of significant points, and relevant supporting detail.
VOCABULARY RANGE AND CONTROL	Shows good control of elementary vocabulary but major errors still occur when expressing more complex thoughts.	Can vary formulation to avoid frequent repetition, but lexical gaps can still cause hesitation and circumlocution.
GRAMMATICAL ACCURACY	Errors occur, but it is clear what he/she is trying to express.	Good grammatical control. Occasional 'slips' or non-systematic errors and minor flaws in sentence structure may still occur, but they are rare.
OVERALL PHONOLOGICAL CONTROL	Pronunciation is generally intelligible, but accent is usually influenced by other language(s) he/she speaks.	Can generally use appropriate intonation, place stress correctly and articulate individual sounds clearly; accent has little or no effect on intelligibility.
