Motor skills disorder (motor coordination disorder,

motor dyspraxia)

- 6% of school age children
- Motor coordination below what is expected
- Anamnesis: delay in the development of MS (sit, walk..), toddlers may have difficulty feeding themselves
- problems with dropping things, handwriting, hand-eye coordination,
- No known exact causes
- the Bruininks-Oseretsky Test of Motor Proficiency (BOT)
- Multimodal treatment

Communication disorders

- Speech and language disorder which refers to problems in communication and in related areas such as oral motor function
- Include many different areas, such as hearing loss, neurological disorders, brain injury, mental retardation ...
- Speech disorder
- Languge disorder
- Hearing disorder
- Central auditory processing disorder
