- *ne?t* = *next, nest, neat (not net)*
- *Internali?ation* = *internalization, internalisation*
- *behavio#r* = *behavior, behaviour (not plural)*
- *colo#r#* = *color, colour (incl. plural)*


□ Remember the use of:

Proximity (N or W)

- tax **N5** reform = tax reform, reform of income tax, etc.
- tax **W8** reform = tax reform (but would not match *reform of income tax*).

The default fields for unqualified searches consist of the following: Title, Translated Title, Classification Codes, Abstract, Keyword, Subjects, and Author.

The following list will help you locate detailed information referenced in this database as a field.

Searchable tag	Description	Example
AB	Abstract [Word Indexed] Searches the abstract summaries for keywords.	AB Art Therapy
AE	Age Group (Exact) [Phrase Indexed] Searches for the exact match of age groups identified in a document.	AE "Infancy (2-23 mo)"
AF	Author Affiliation [Word Indexed] Searches for keywords in the institutional affiliation of the person(s) responsible for creation of the document.	AF Clark University
AG	Age Group [Word Indexed] Searches age groups identified in a document; values consist of the following:	AG Infancy





Playlists



Database users can create playlists containing videos, clips of portions of videos, or links to other Web pages. Playlists are typically created around a topic, and users may title their playlists to reflect this. Users can also add notes to assist others in understanding and enjoying their playlist. A playlist may be shared using its static URL, making playlists very useful for pointing colleagues and students toward videos and other material of interest. Professors can also create a selection of clips to show in a class or as assigned viewing for homework. Users can see their own playlists by clicking on "My Playlists" on the upper right-hand side of the screen after logging in.

The My Playlists tab contains a user's personal playlists, and are only visible to individual users.
