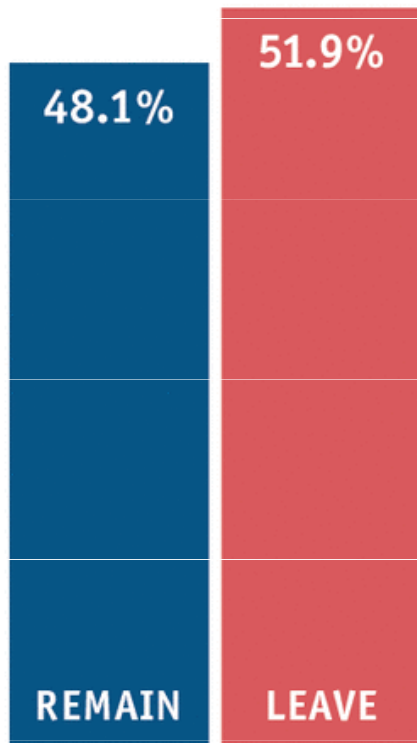

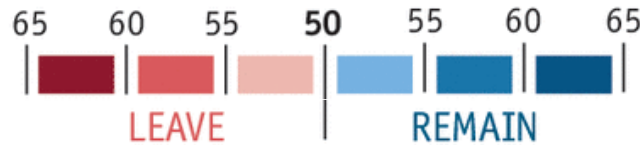

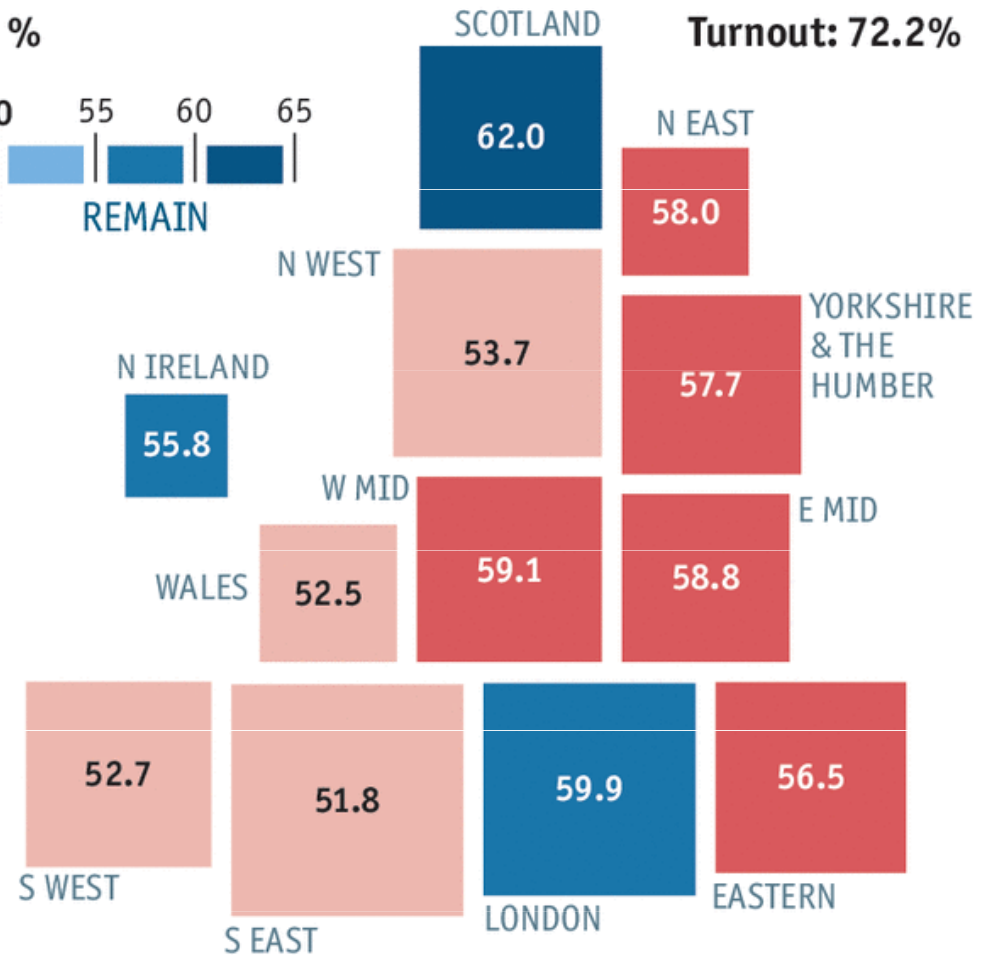
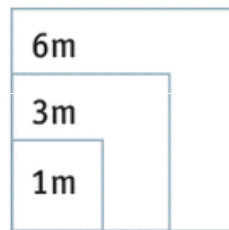

## Results by region, %



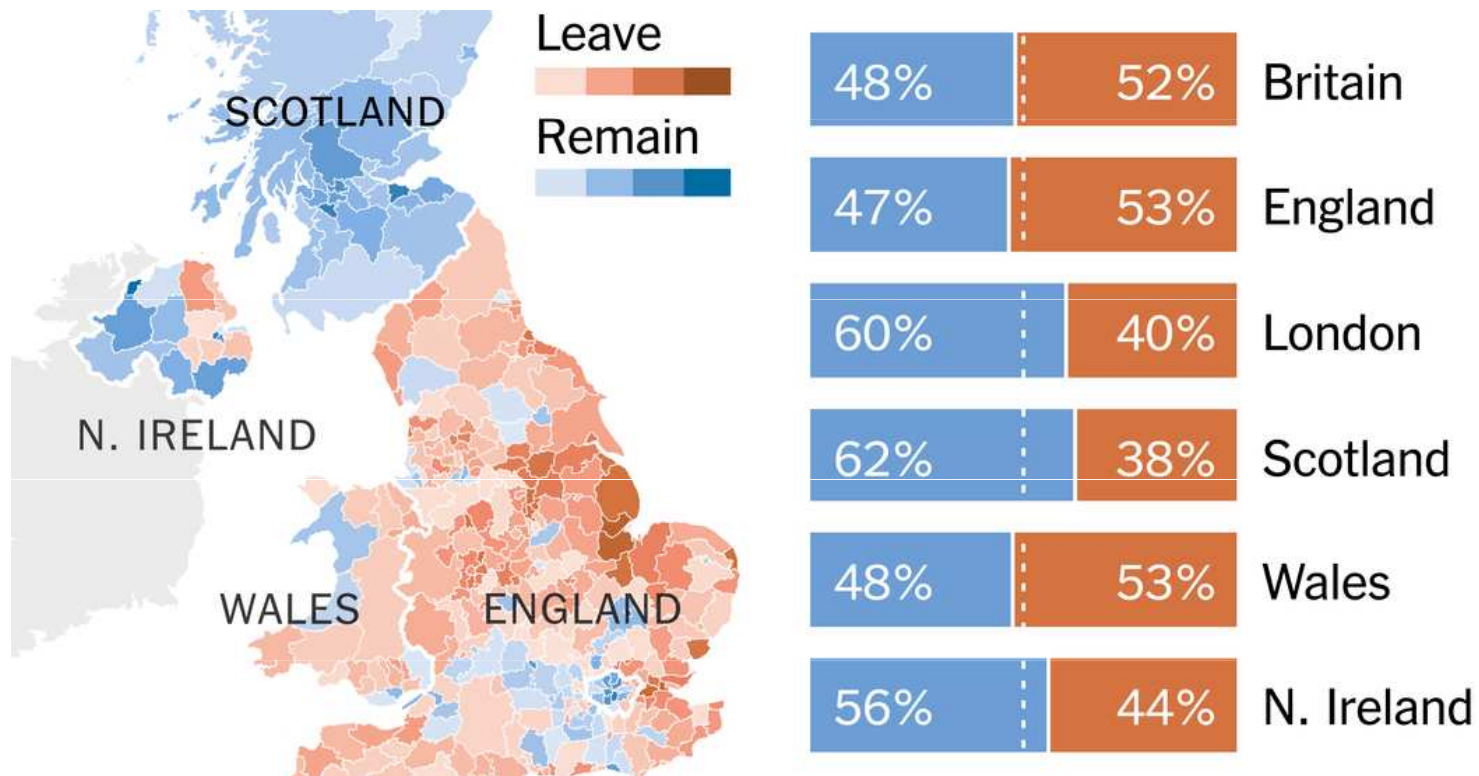
Turnout: 72.2%

– Clear geographical differences



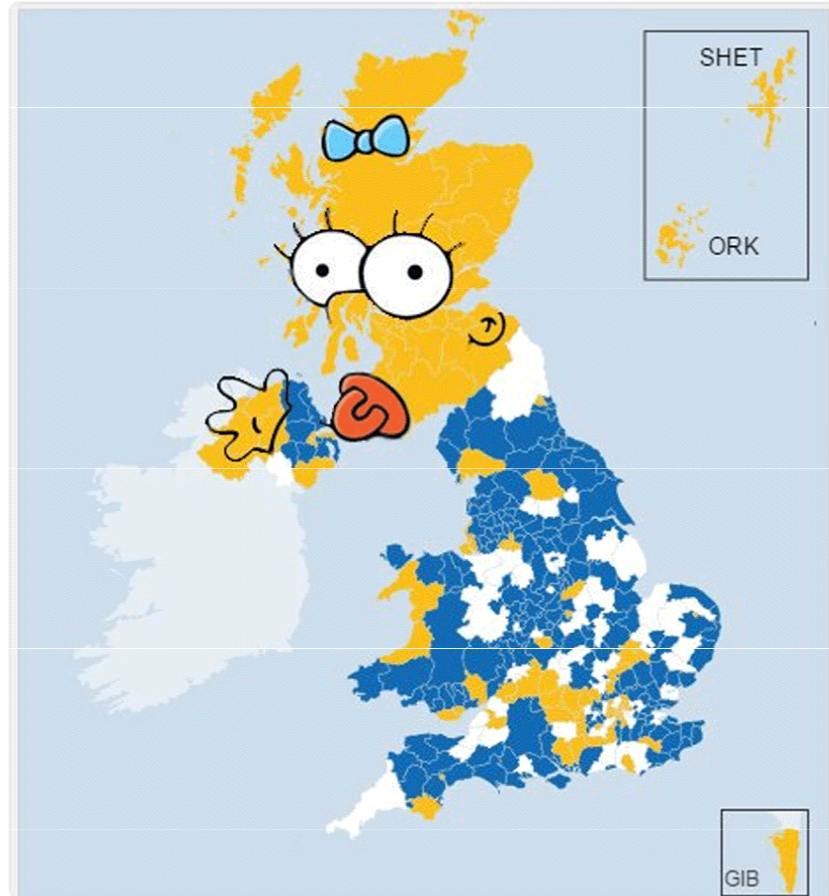

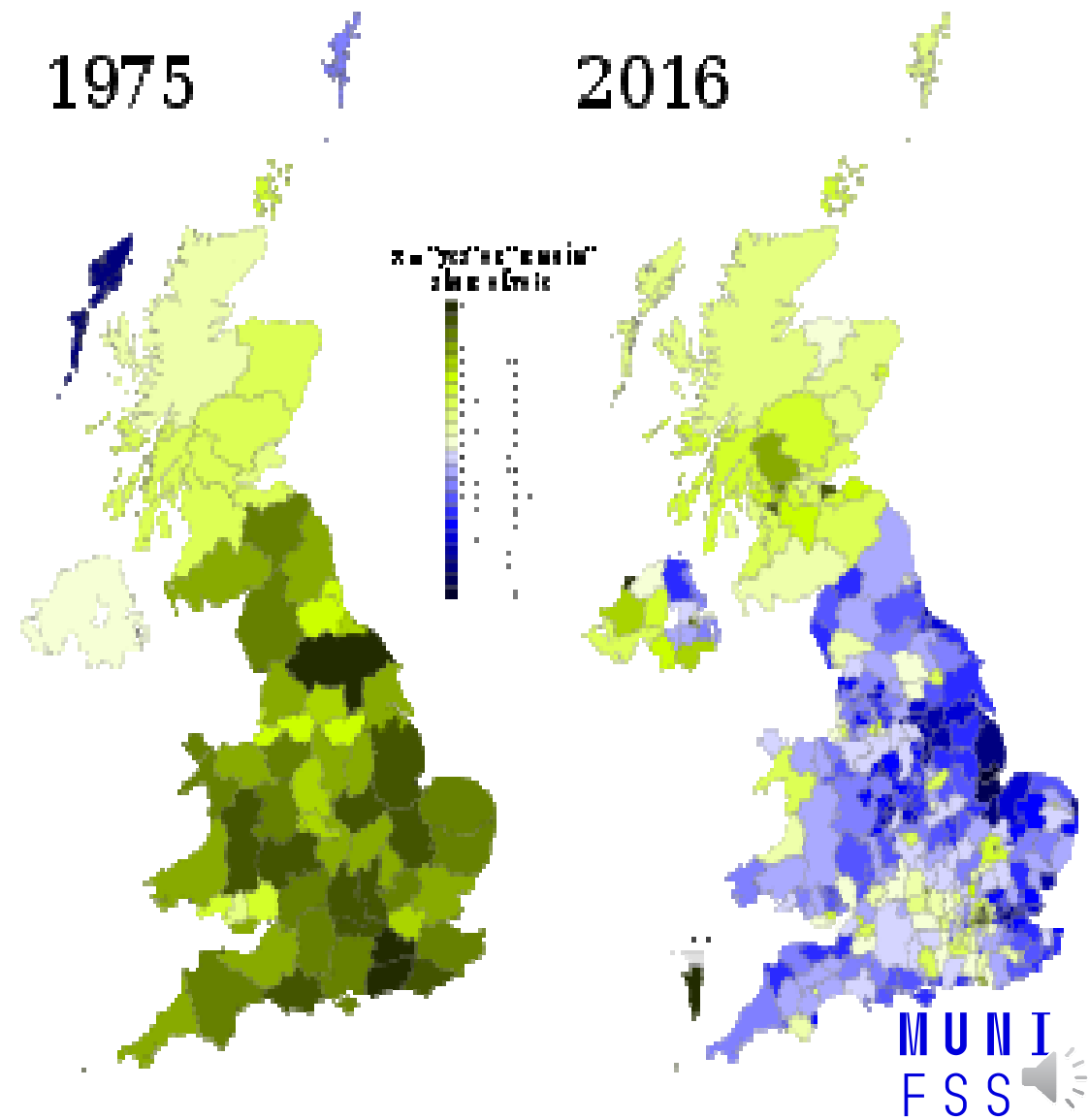

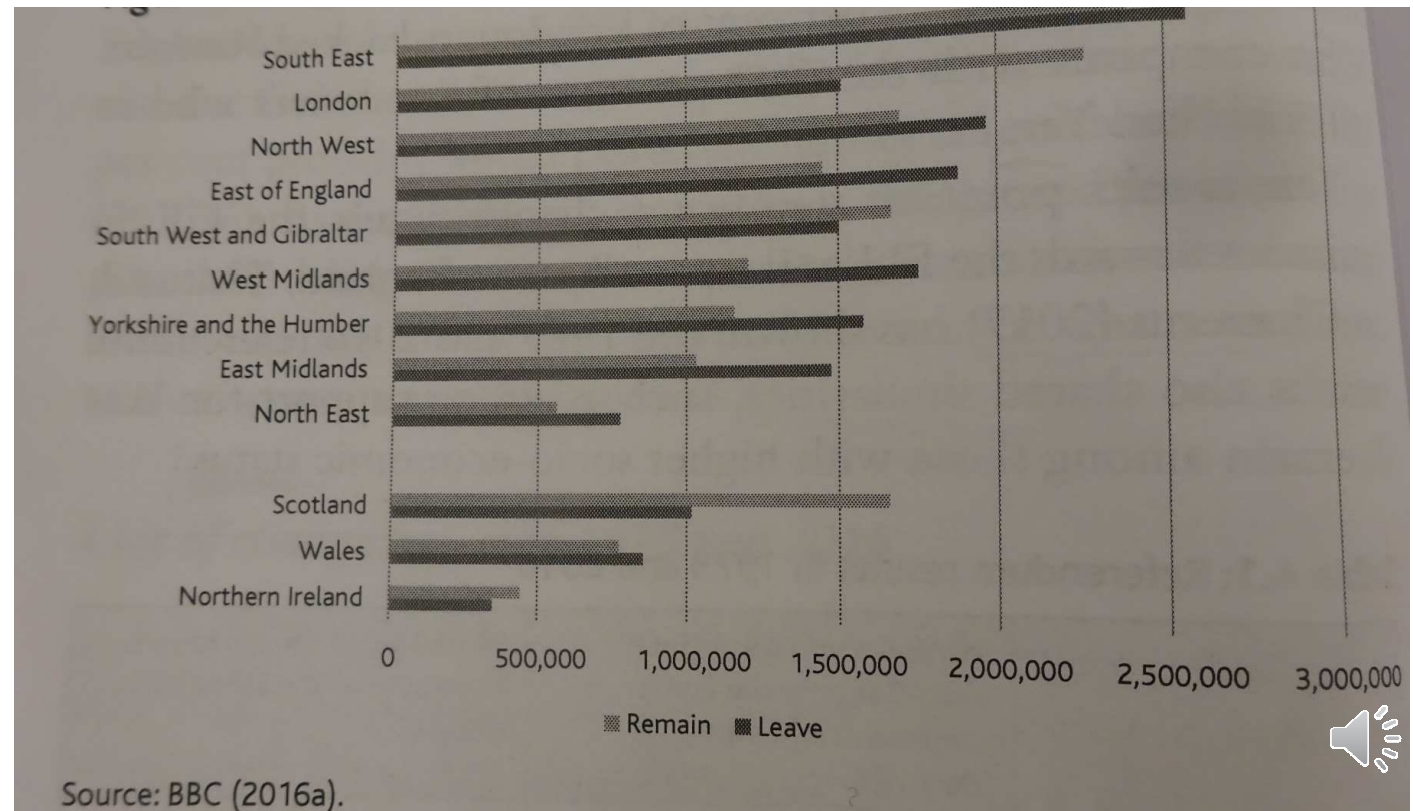

- The referendum was decided in England

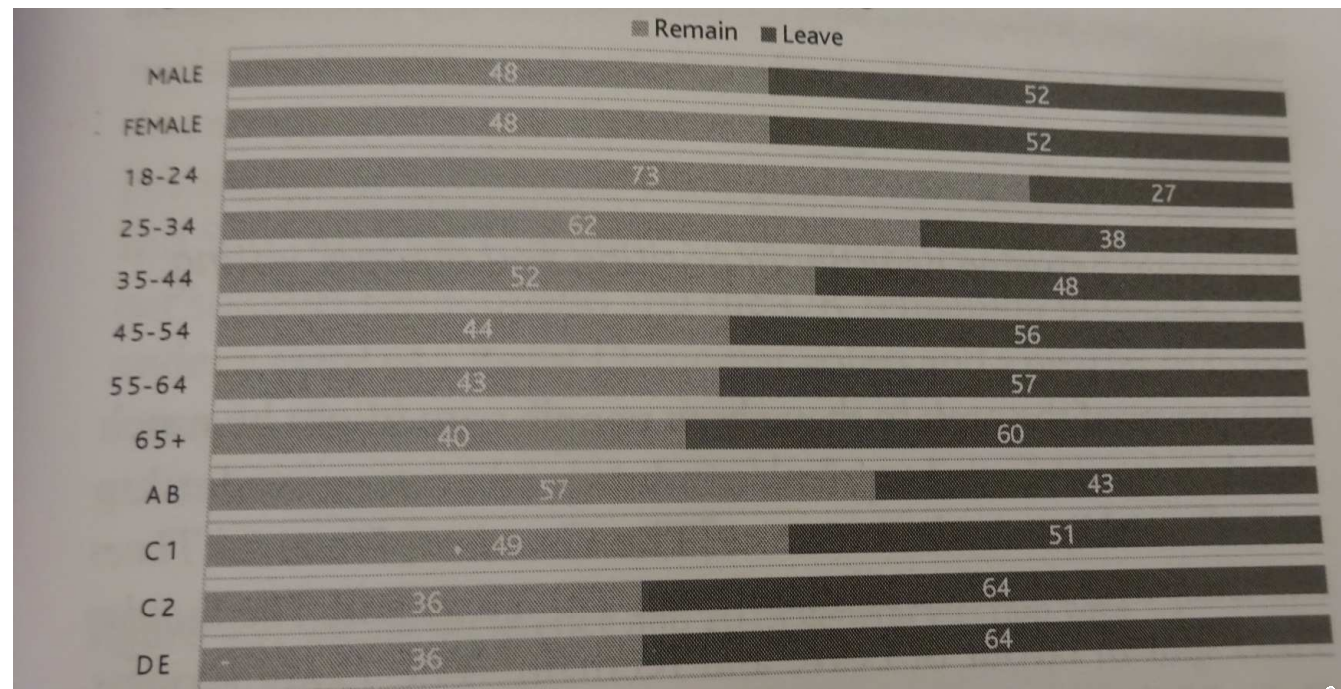
*Total votes cast in each UK region*

*Demographic breakdown of voters*



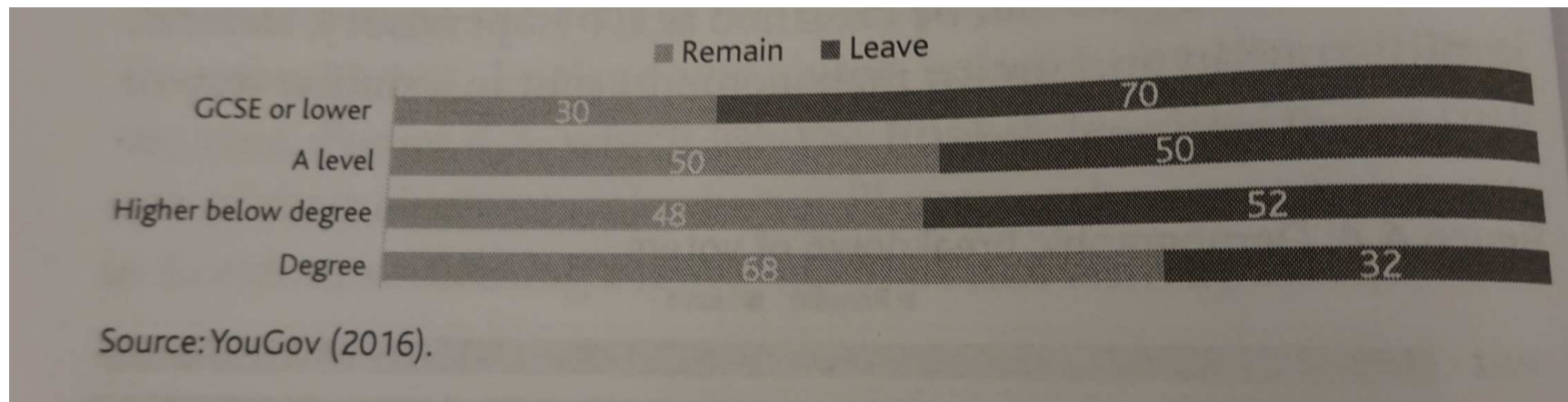

*Educational levels of Remain and Leave voters*

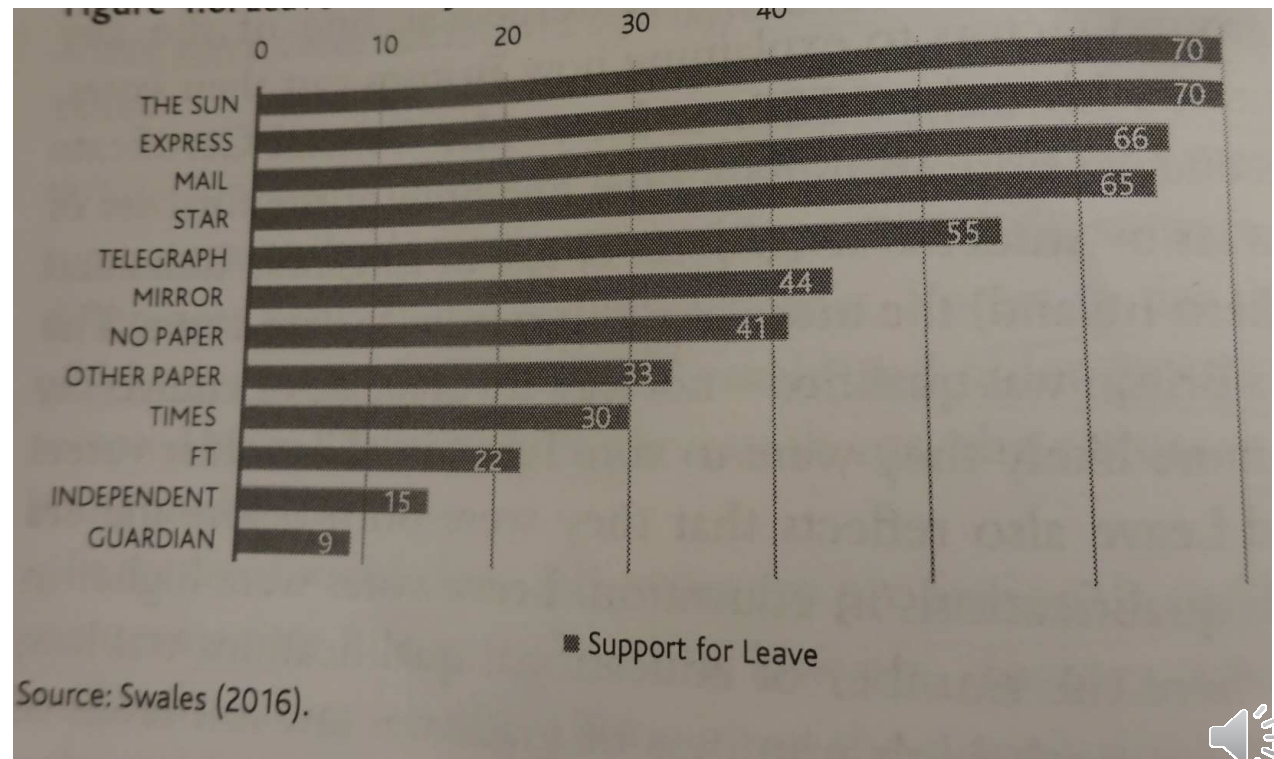




# The referendum result

- Alignment between newspaper position and readers' voting intention

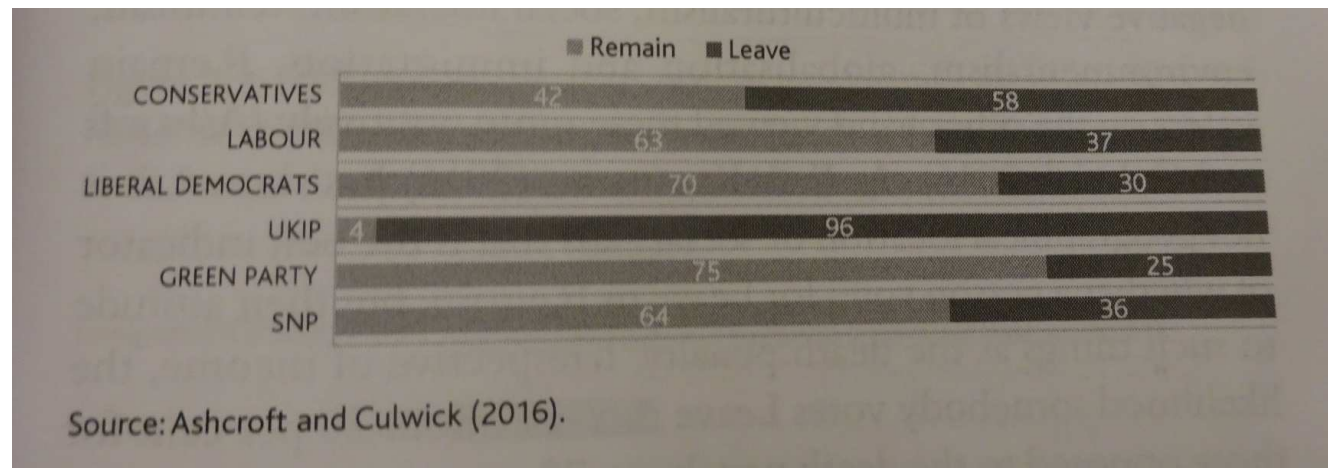
*Leave vote by newspaper read most often*

- Large numbers of people voted differently from the position of the party they voted for in the 2015 election

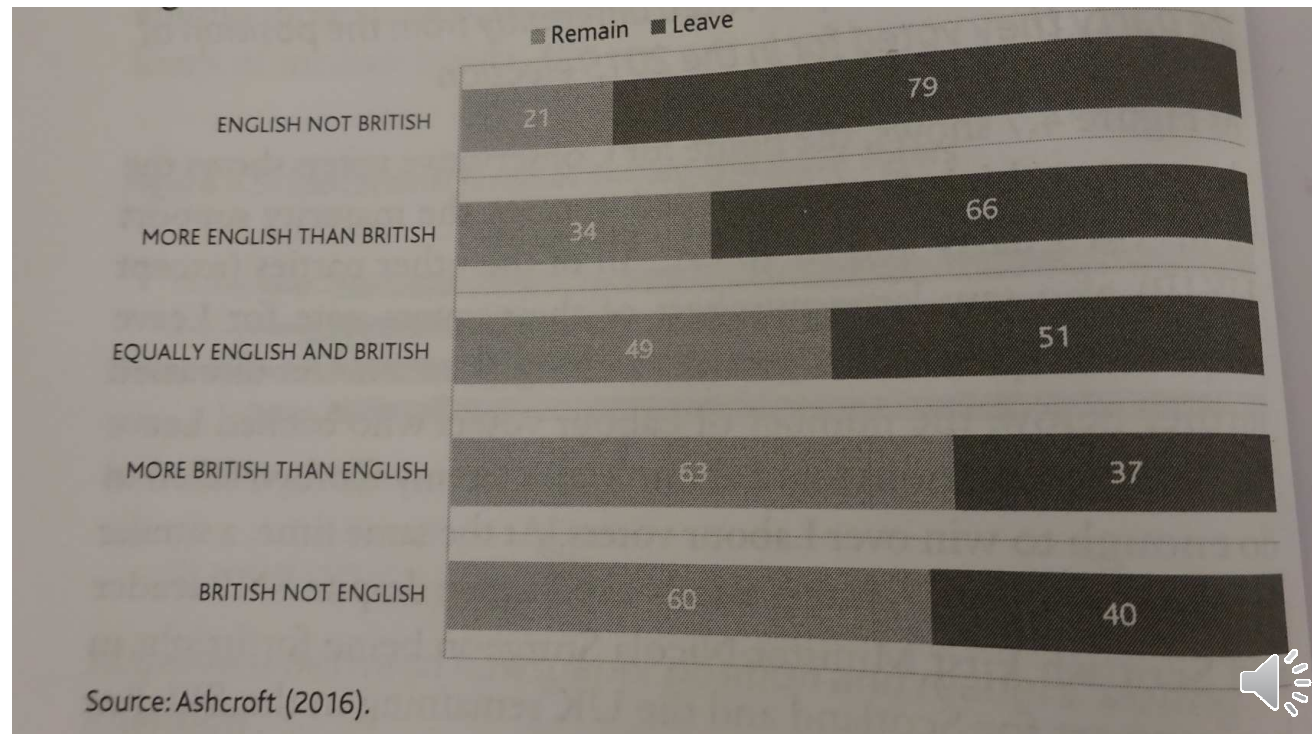
*Voting preference and 2015 general election vote*

*Votes according to strength of English and British identity*



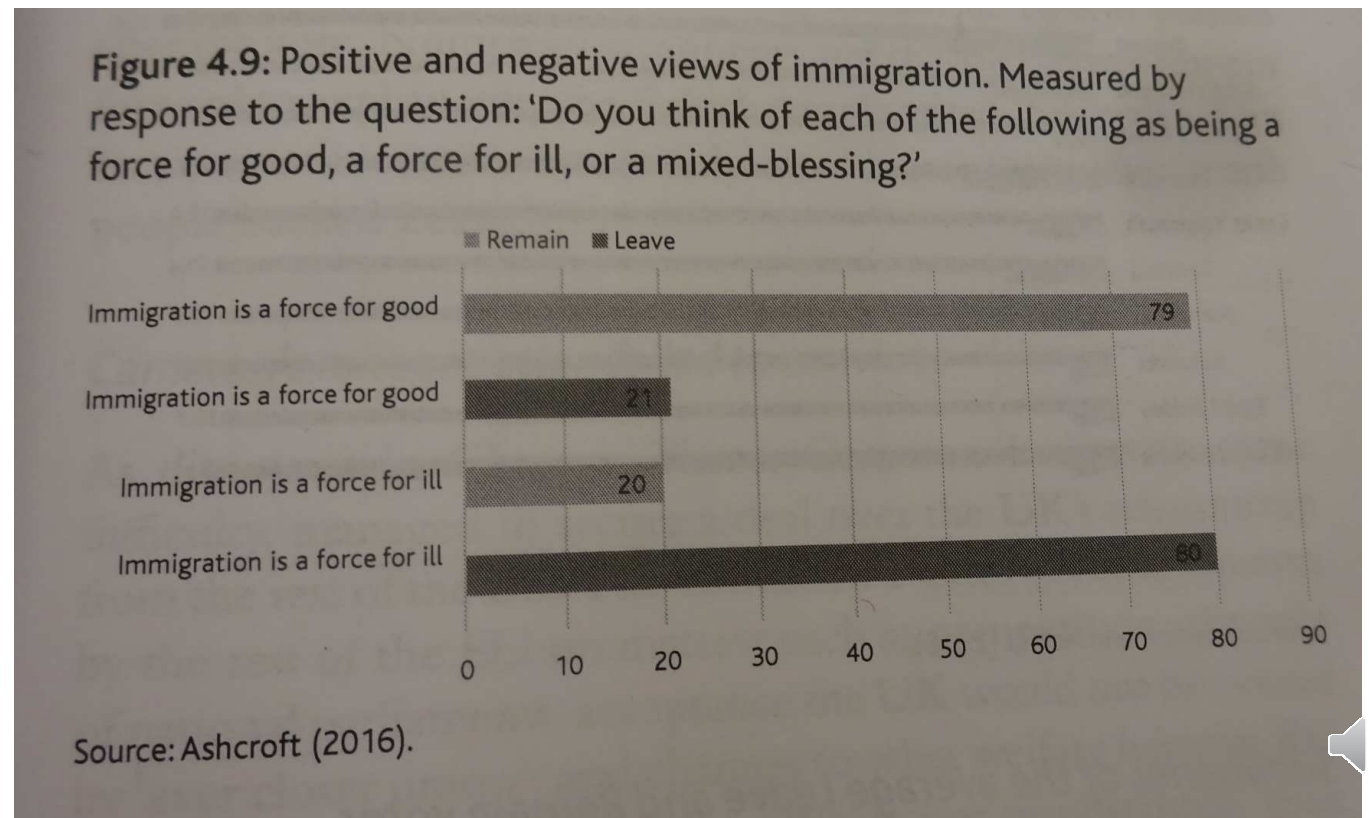

- Remain and Leave voters divided by values



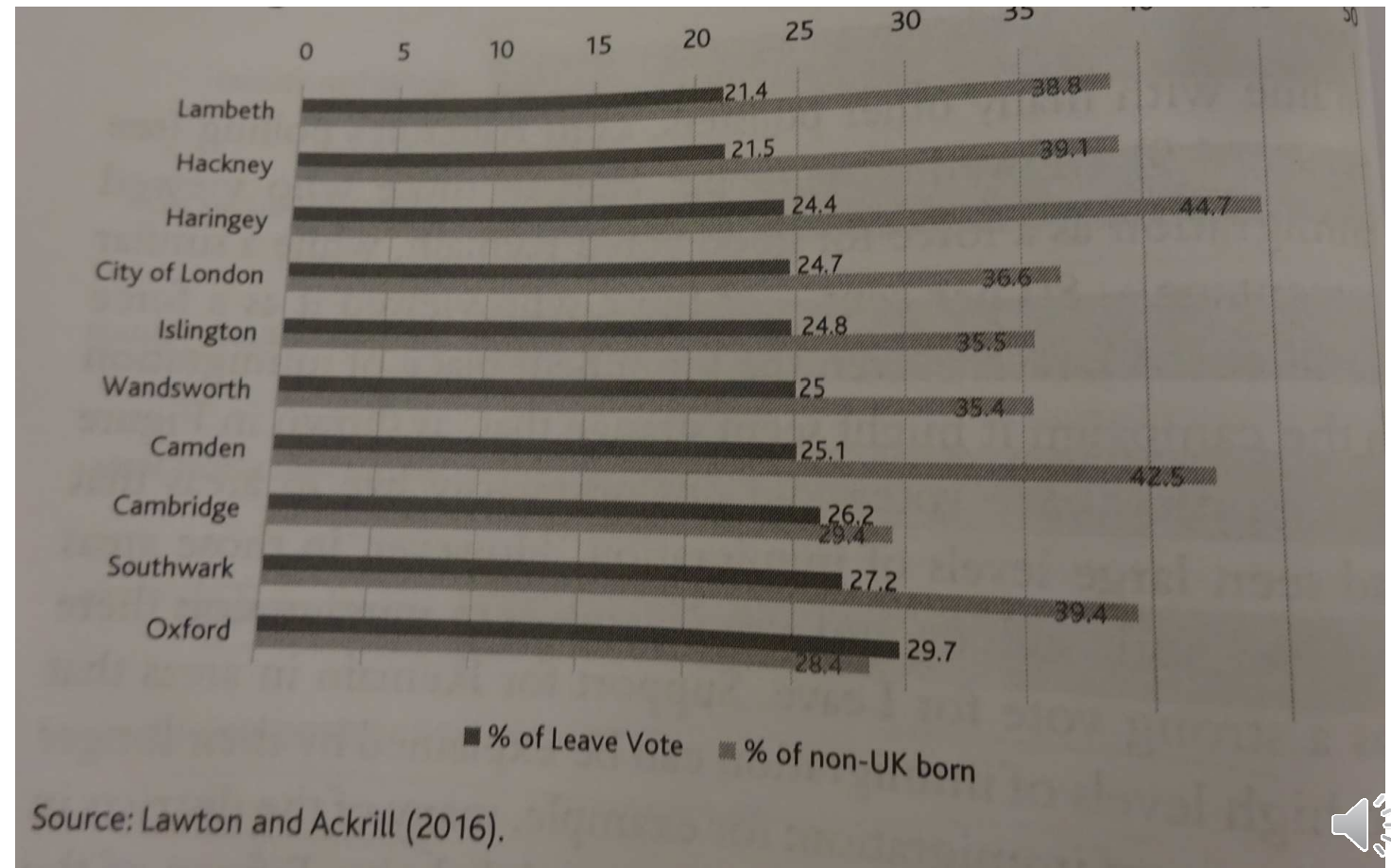

- Views and experiences of immigration were important dividing lines



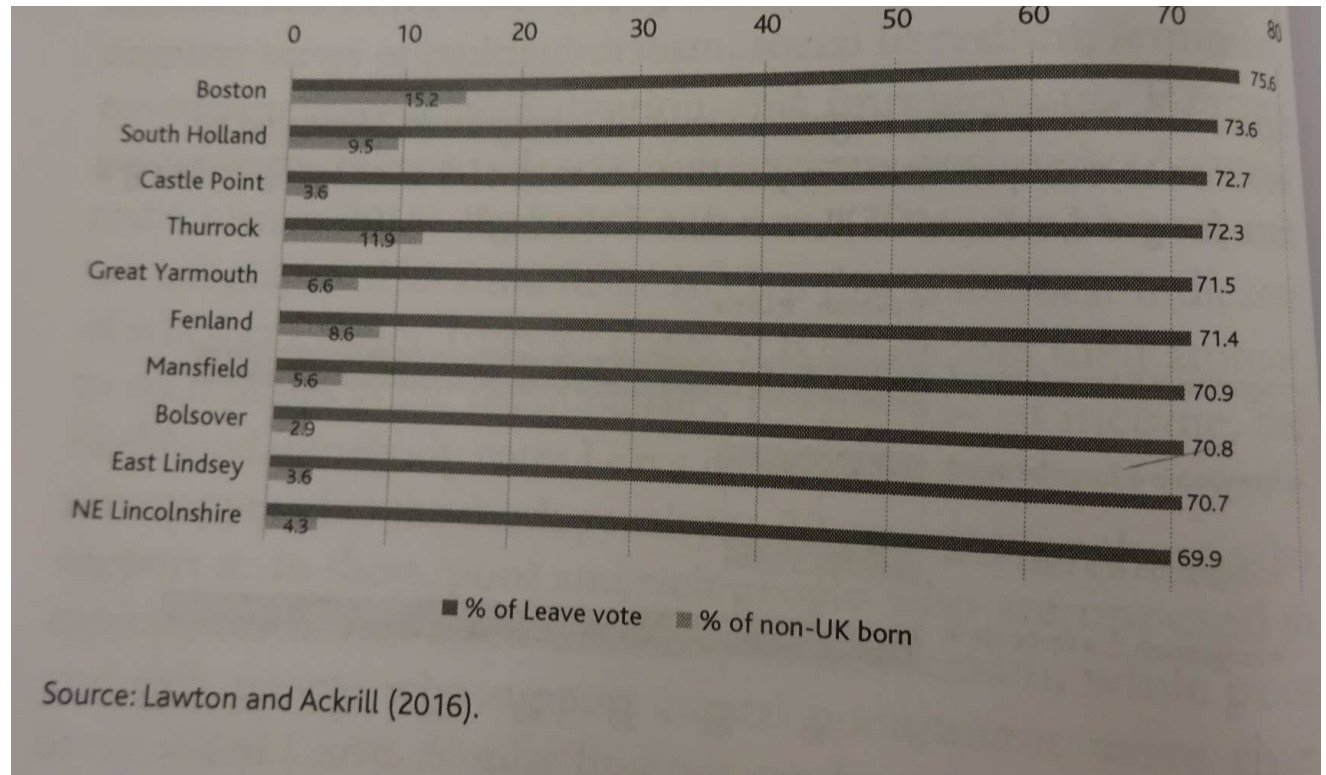
