




# Christian Perspectives I

- Humility and Human Fallibility

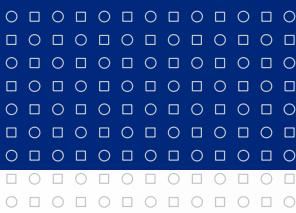

- Personal Autonomy






# Civic Peace

- Weakness of this Justification






# Intermediate Institutions

- Weakness of Rationale

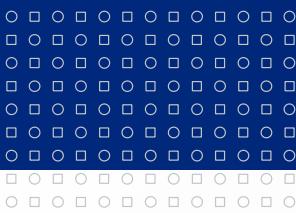

- Drawbacks of Justification


