




Democratic Diarchy

- will and opinion are the two powers of the democratic sovereign. They are different ans should remain distinct, although in need of constant communication."
- Representative Democracy v. Epistemic
 Democracy (deliberation of nonelected bodies)
 and Populism (opinion of the part of the people merge with the will of the state)
