- 3. Explain the foreign policy strategy of Israel from 1948-1973?
- 4. Explain how building the economy of Israel in the 1950s underwent both an 'economic' test and a 'reparations' test and how natural resources and technology nowadays is the engine for the Israeli econom?
- 5. Discuss the foreign policy effects of the 1973 Yom Kipper War on Israel?
- 6. Why was the Oslo Accords important for Israeli foreign policy?
- 7. Explain how the 'low-grade' conflict between Israel and the Palestinians has created a status quo? Is this reality favorable to both sides?
- 8. At the 'basic' level, what is the relationship between Israel and the US, and how does it inform the foreign policy of Israel?
- 9. Why is Israeli foreign policy towards Africa important?
- 10. Israel has friends and enemies; how has the Abraham Accords benefited Israel's ability to influence the Arab world and what single issue is constant?
