## Advanced Methods of Interpretation in Cultural Sociology

The lecture<br>concludes with a written test, which consists<br>of a question-and-answer part as well as an<br>interpretation exercise as practical part. | The bi-weekly seminar accompanies the lecture<br>with additional readings and interpretation<br>exercises.
