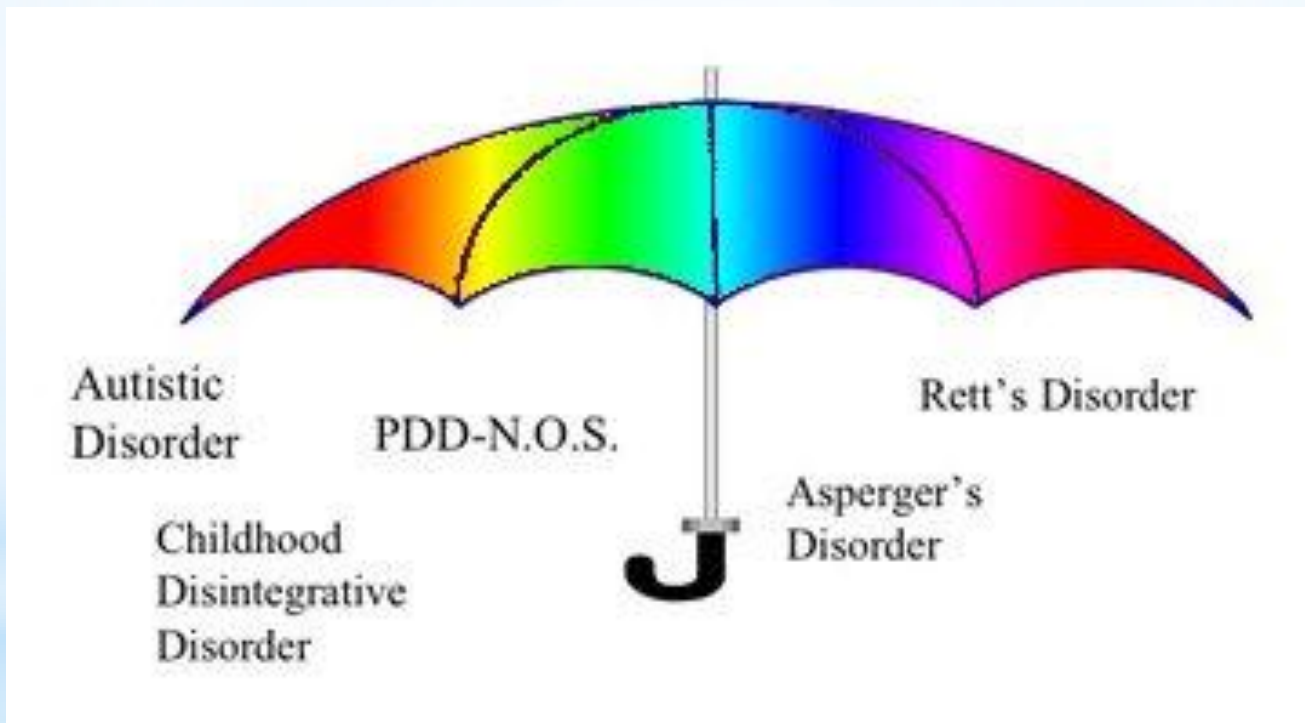

DSM IV- TR

Pervasive Developmental Disorder: disorders usually first diagnosed in infancy, childhood or adolescence.

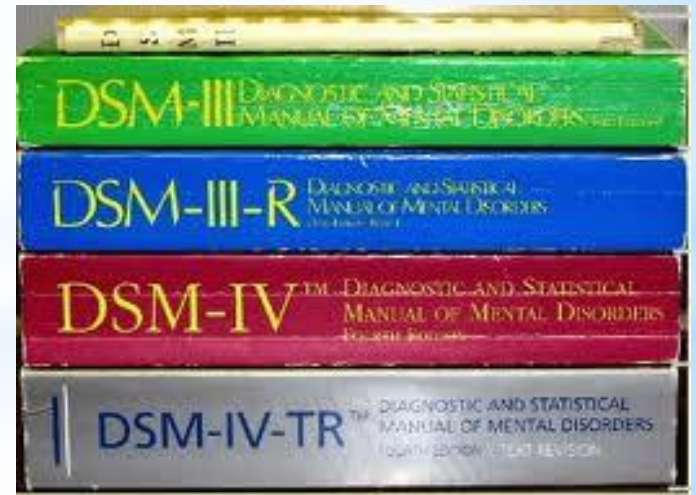
Includes:

- Autistic Disorder
- Aspergers Disorder
- Pervasive Developmental Disorder- Not Otherwise Specified (PDD-NOS).
- Childhood Disintegrative Disorder (CDD)

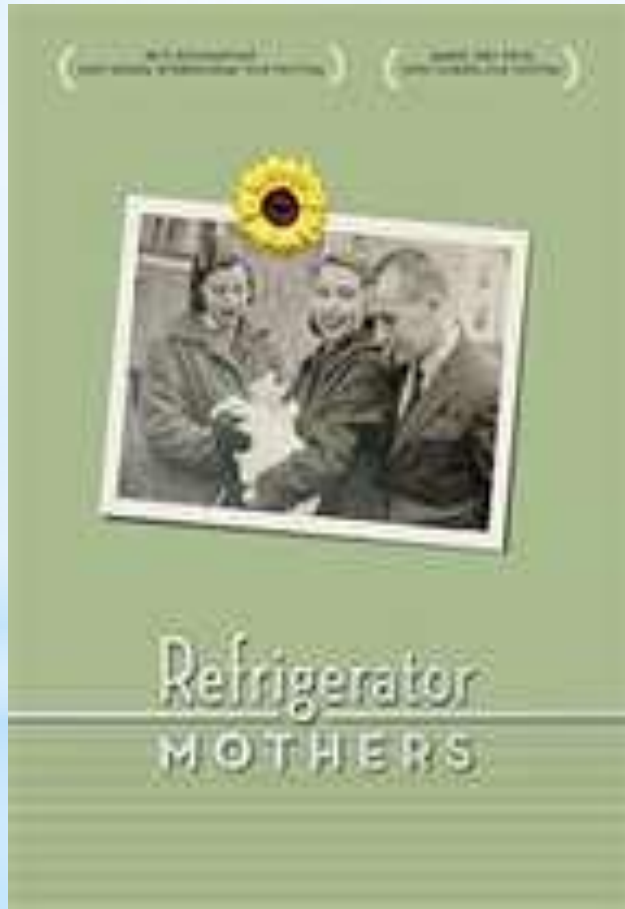

What causes autism?





Strong genetic basis:

... although how and what structural and biochemical events occur, when and in what order it occurs in is unknown



Environmental risk factor:

any event occurring *after* FERTILISATION

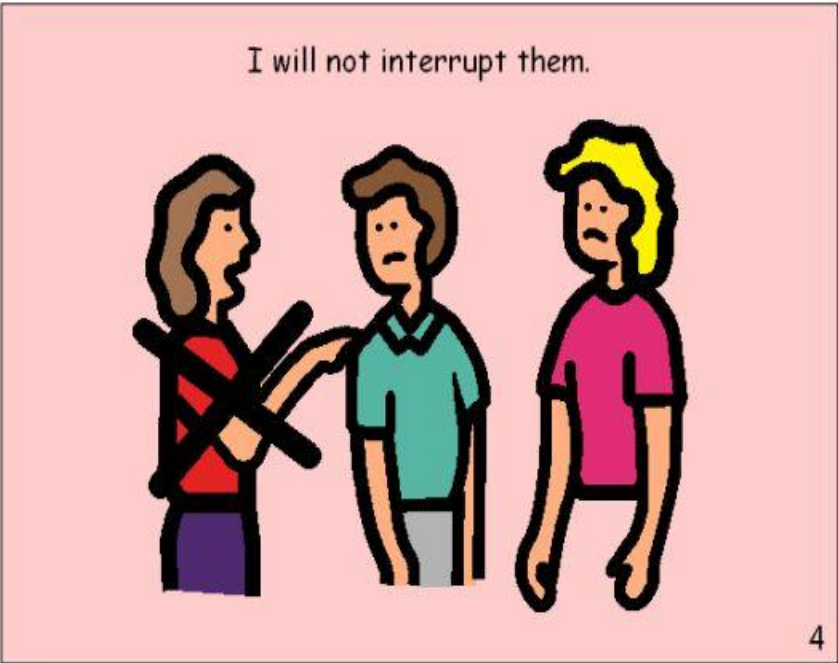
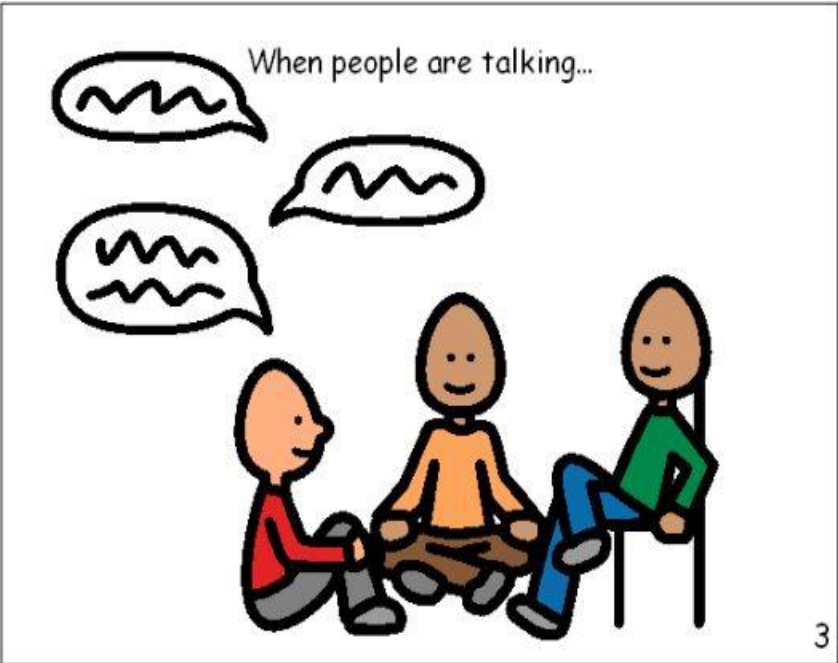




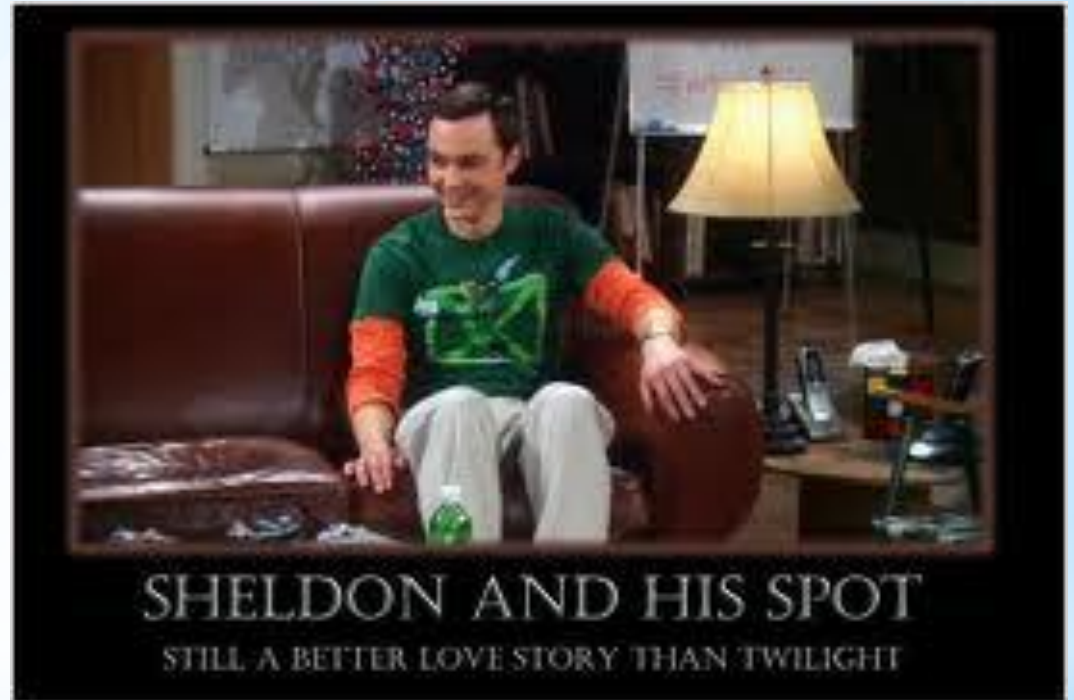
Fig. 1 Example of a prompting page on the Cyrano Communicator

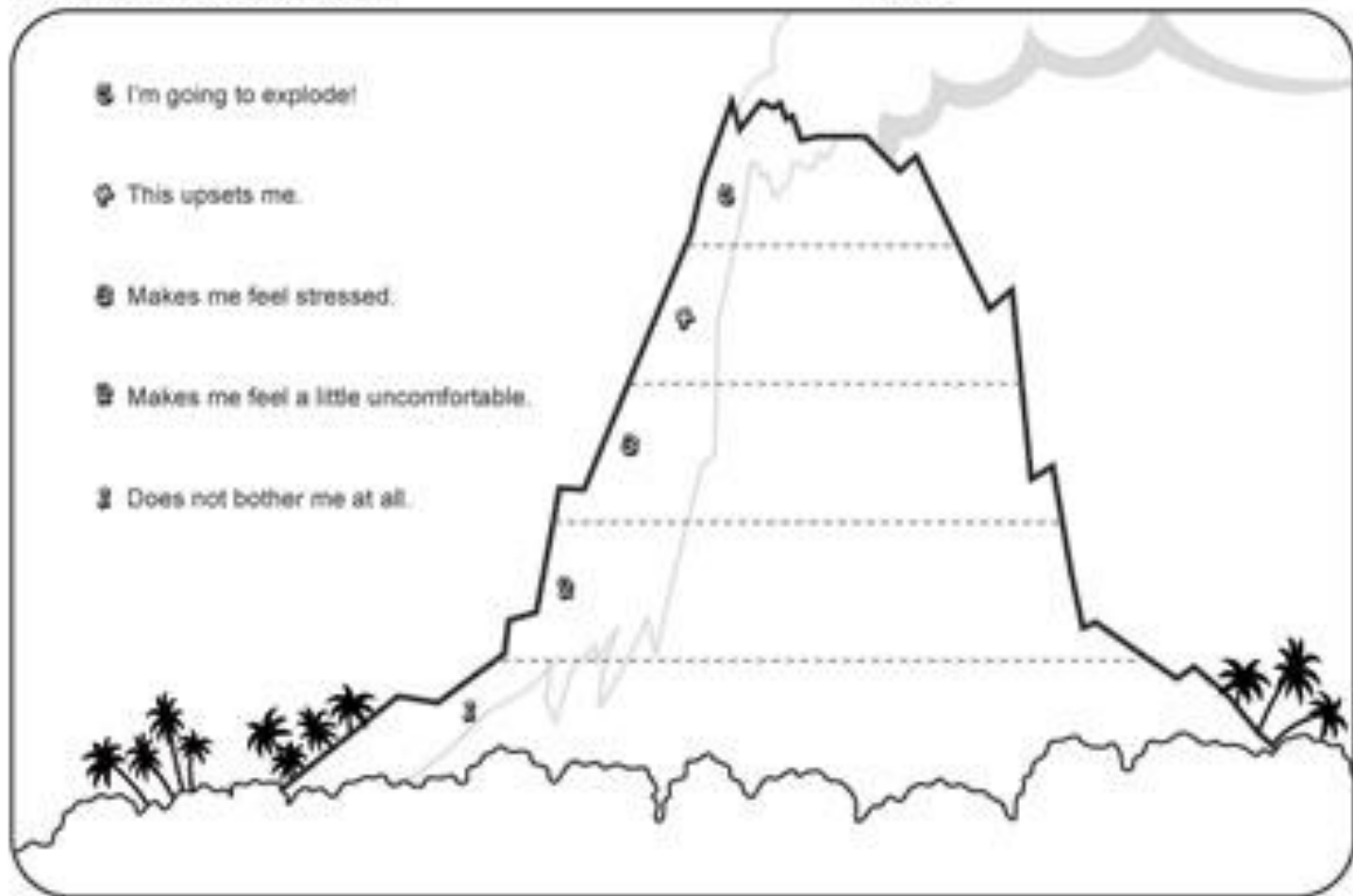

Theory of Mind in autism



Autism and links to Theory of Mind:

- *Executive functioning: cognitive flexibility, planning
- *Language (inner speech and outer speech)
- *Self-awareness (empathy)
- *Intellectual functioning
- *Sensory and perception issues
