Cargo railway station Prague - Žižkov

Cargo railway station in Prague city quarter Žižkov is a specific city site with long history and uncertain future. It was built in 1930's on the edge of Prague as one of the most important transport node for the city.

The station is officially out of service for cargo since 2002, except a few trains per week and several private storages, which is not sufficient, according to the size of space, which the train station takes up.

Nowadays there is discussion about the future function and looks of the space – according to its specific architecture site, the original buildings were (after long discussion) declared as part of cultural heritage, although several developers plans count with redevelopment of whole area.
