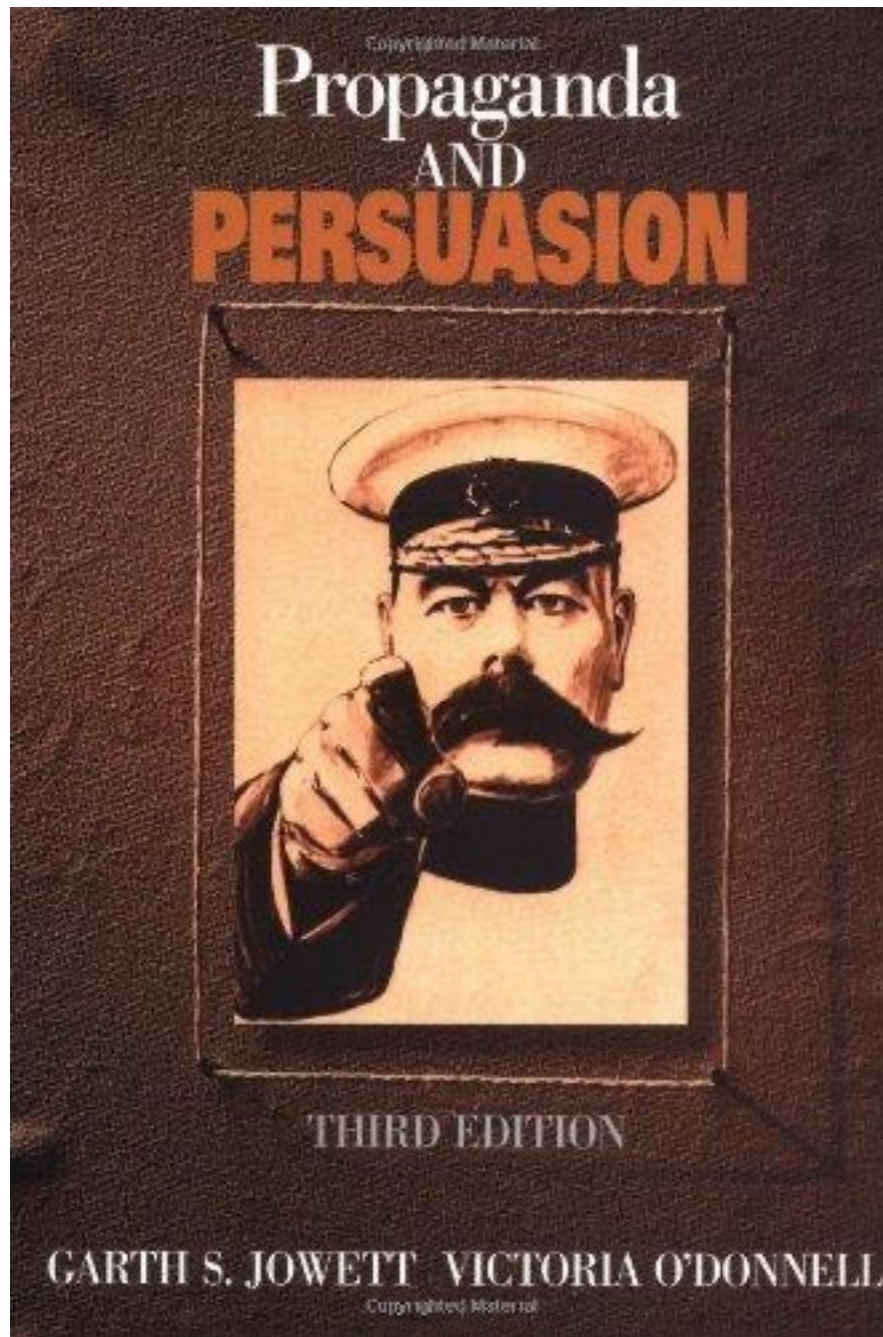

definition of propaganda



“Propaganda is the deliberate, systematic attempt to shape perceptions, manipulate cognitions, and direct behavior to achieve a response that furthers the desired intent of the propagandist.”

definition of propaganda

“Propaganda is neutrally defined as a systematic form of purposeful persuasion that attempts to influence the emotions, attitudes, opinions, and actions of specified target audiences for ideological, political or commercial purposes through the controlled transmission of one-sided messages (which may or may not be factual) via mass and direct media channels.”

origin and development of the term 'propaganda'

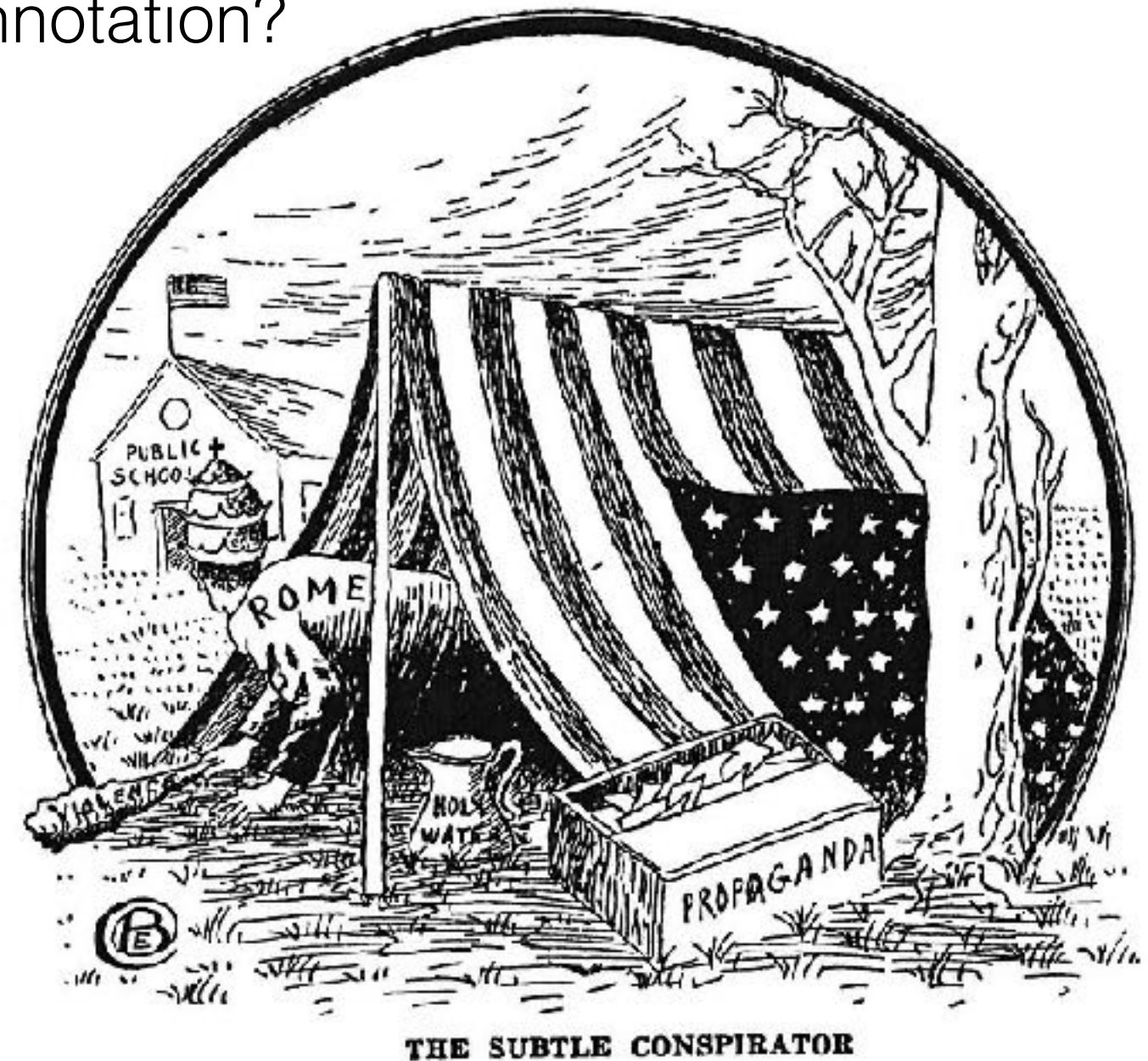
- ▶ 1622: Pope Gregory XV established the Sacra Congregatio de Propaganda Fidel (Sacred Congregation for Propagation of the Faith)
- ▶ The term not widespread until the beginning of 20th century



origin and development of the term 'propaganda'

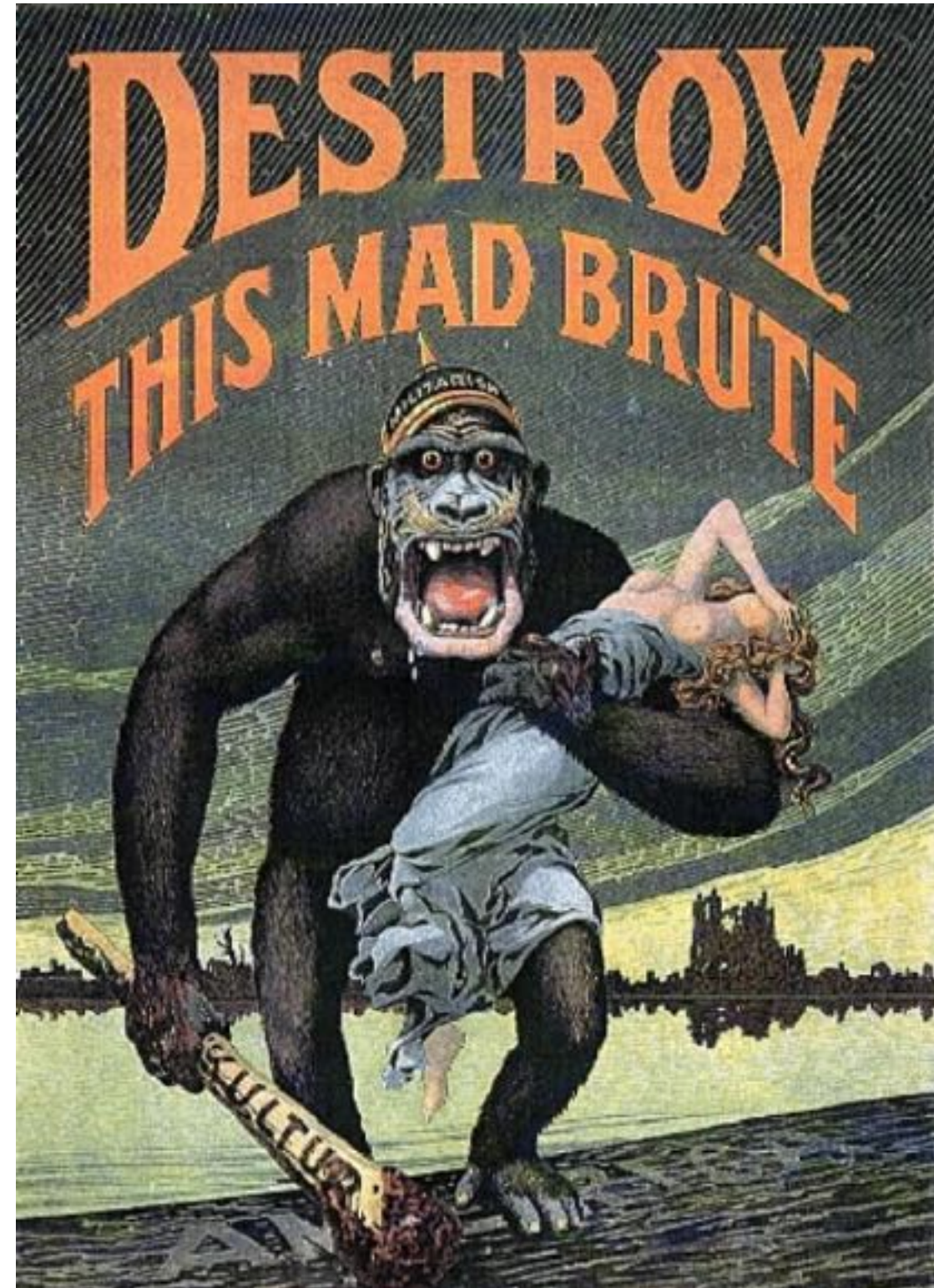
- ▶ neutral, positive, or negative connotation?

In English, propaganda was originally a neutral term for the dissemination of information in favor of any given cause.

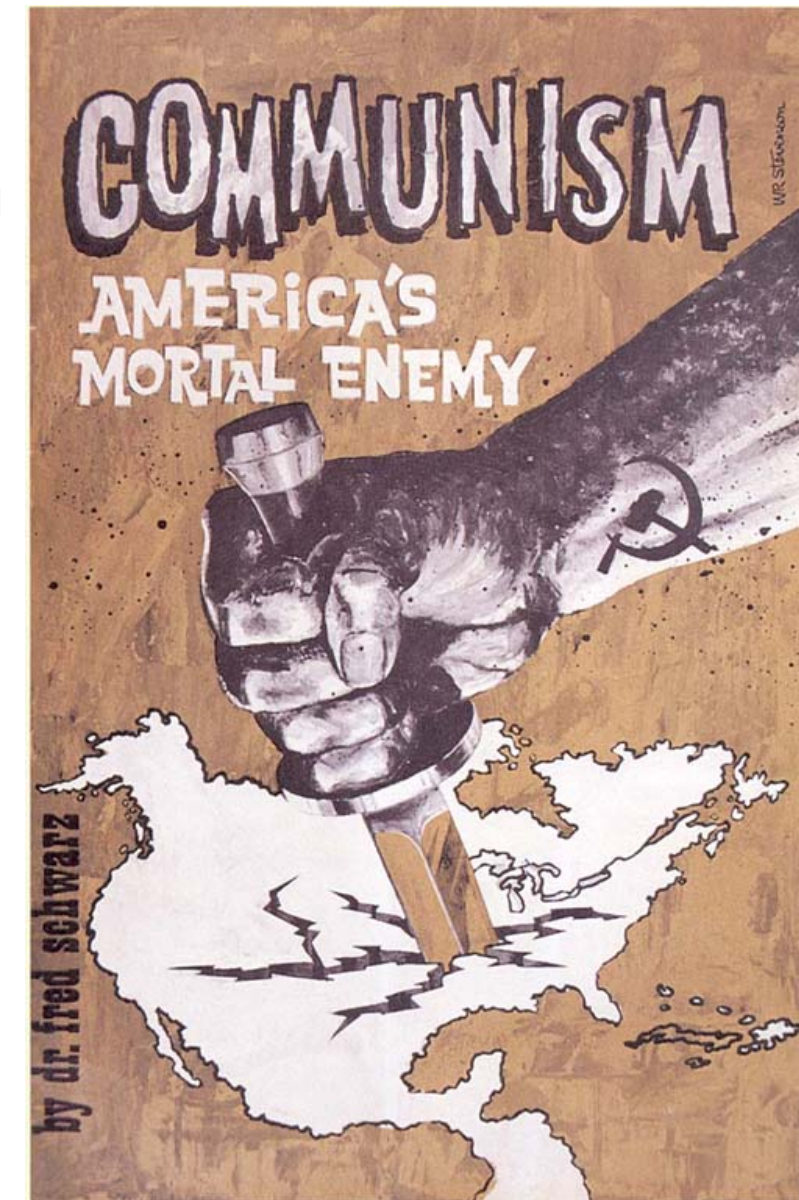


origin and development of the term 'propaganda'

- ▶ change during the 20th century



- ▶ governments seek to **persuade citizens**
- ▶ propaganda against enemy's own population
- ▶ disinformation used to distract people from the truth and **create new reality**
- ▶ Nazi Germany: Reich Ministry of Public Enlightenment and Propaganda
- ▶ Anti Communist Propaganda

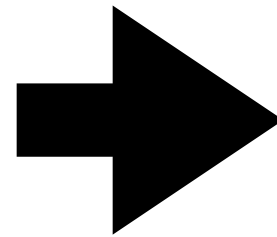
propaganda used to be divided into three types

Russian propaganda strategies: confuse and obfuscate

The MH17 disinformation smokescreen

15 months of Russian misinformation and fakes around 298 MH17 victims

THIS IS WHAT HAPPENS IF RUSSIAN MEDIA QUESTIONS MORE

Conspiracy 1
The Ukrainian military downed MH17 by a Su-25 fighter jet.
Pitched by: Russian MoD, developed by Russian investigative committee and media

Conspiracy 2
The Ukrainian military downed MH17 with a Ukrainian Buk
Pitched by: Russian MoD, developed by Russian state missile manufacturer Almaz-Antey
Modification: MH17 was downed by a Su-25

MH17 WAS DOWNED ON 17 JULY 2014 IN DONBAS WITH A RUSSIAN BUK MISSILE COMPLEX FROM SEPARATIST-CONTROLLED TERRITORY.

Conspiracy 3
The Ukrainian government was responsible with a Ukrainian Buk

Conspiracy 4
The Ukrainian military downed the plane in a botched bid to assassinate Putin

Conspiracy 5
It was Israel

Conspiracy 6
It was an attempt to assassinate the Indian Prime Minister Indira Gandhi

Conspiracy 7
It was a result of CIA guided by the IMF and its head, Christine Lagarde.

Conspiracy 8
It was the Islamist attempting to conceal the truth about ADO

... but it has changed in some ways

- ▶ boom of **disinformation media outlets**
- ▶ paid **internet trolls**
- ▶ direct **influence on political parties** (financial)
- ▶ establishing cultural/ religious **organizations**, NGOs

what is the propaganda nowadays?

- ▶ does not necessarily tells lies
- ▶ should strengthen existing believes
- ▶ The news media's focus on objectivity and covering “both” sides of a story also plays into the hands of a deceiver attempting to spread a story based on altered images. Media provide both stories with equal time and rarely offers objective, rigorous analysis.

Great propagandist is a man who tells the truth, or selects truth that serves his purposes, and tells it in such way the recipient does not think that he is receiving any propaganda.
