

Life story

- **The instructions for the life story events were as follows:**

“This part deals with your personal life story. Your task is to decide which events are most central to the story of your own life. It has to be events that you have personally experienced. It is your personal life and personal life story that this task is about.

There are no right or wrong answers. You are the one who knows best what has been central to your life.

Imagine that you are to tell your life story to a new friend, whom you have just met and who therefore doesn't know anything about your past. It is a (fictitious) friend with whom you are absolutely confident and with whom you can be completely honest. Your task is to note the **seven memories about events from your own personal life** – from your birth to your present age – that you think are most central to your life story.

Write the events in the same order as they come to your mind. Give each event a short title so that you yourself are able to identify the event afterwards”.

- Tranzitná (prechodná) udalosť: historického vs. osobného charakteru
- „historical transitional events“ majú vplyv na datovanie autobiografických spomienok ľudí určitej krajiny

Living in History: výskum

- Historické tranzitné udalosti môžu predstavovať v autobiografickej pamäti osôb takzvané *Historically Defined Autobiographical Periods*

Tranzitnej Udalosti (HTU):

Bosna (občianska vojna; Brown at al., 2009)

Izmit, Turecko (zemetrasenie, Brown at al., 2009)

Libanon (občianska vojna 1975-1990; Zebian & Brown, 2013)

Kedy sa jedná o HTU?

- Zasiachnutie všetkých občanov danej oblasti
- Priame následky udalosti na životoch občanov
- Krvavý konflikt či živelná katastrofa so stratami na životoch
- Udalosť ovplyvnila takmer všetky oblasti každodenného života väčšiny zasiahnutých

This event has impacted me psychologically.

This event has influenced my understanding of right and wrong.

Metoda

- Zozbierať Life stories (CZ/SK) $N=120 \times 2$ (Dotazník Qualtrics)
- TIS preklad (existuje) overiť jeho vlastnosti
- Ku každému life story event administrovať TIS
- Porovnať life stories s life scripts CZ/SK
- Zistiť prepojenie scriptic vs. non-scriptic life story events a transitional events (viz. RQ)
- *odhad: rok a pol práce pre dvoch, dve DP, jedna zahr. publikácia*

Are all the life story events transitional events? (do they obtain all the necessary characteristics for transitional events?)

How do the scriptic vs non-scriptic life story events differ in TIS?

Positive life story events vs. negative life story events. How do they differ in the TIS?

Are all the transitional events mentioned in the life story scriptic? If not, how are non-scriptic events different from the scriptic ones?

H1: (Positive transitional events being scriptic/ negative transitional events non-scriptic)

Do positive and negative transitional events form a period boundary similarly often?
