FINAL PRESENTATION REQUIREMENTS

I have provided a list of songs by the Beatles and their lyrics. Pick one of the songs provided and create 12 images based on the lyrics of that song.

Use the lyrics as the titles of your photographs.

The photographs DO NOT NEED to tell a story. They DO NOT need to be for the entire song. They DO NOT need to be connected to each other.


They can be completely independent of each other except for the fact their titles come from the same song.

Example. If your song is "Michelle," every time they say the word "Michelle," it could a portrait of a person. Each portrait could be a different person.

You need to include portraiture and Photoshop. If you are able to include the other elements from class, that is a bonus. The photos must be well composed and properly exposed. Follow the rule of thirds.

Here are two examples of partial presentations. One of them, if continued to completion, would pass. The other, if continued to completion, would fail.

THIS EXAMPLE, if completed, WOULD NOT PASS. It shows poor work and a complete lack of effort.





