

# General Report on the Administration of the State

In accordance with the provisions of the Constitution, the following report is presented to the Legislature on the state of the State during the year 1875.

The year 1875 has been marked by a period of relative tranquility and progress in the various departments of the State.

Under the direction of the Executive Council, the various departments have been managed with care and efficiency.

The Department of Education has made considerable progress in the improvement of the public schools.

The Department of Agriculture has been successful in promoting the interests of the farming community.

The Department of Public Works has been engaged in the construction of several important buildings.

The Department of Finance has managed the State's affairs with economy and efficiency.

The following table shows the results of the various departments during the year 1875.

Department of Education: The number of children attending school has increased by 10%.

Department of Agriculture: The yield of wheat has increased by 15%.

Department of Public Works: The cost of construction has been kept within the budget.

Department of Finance: The State's revenue has increased by 8%.

Department of Justice: The courts have been kept busy with the cases brought before them.

Department of Internal Affairs: The State's police forces have been reorganized for greater efficiency.

Department of External Affairs: The State has maintained friendly relations with its neighbors.

Department of the Navy: The State's naval forces have been maintained at a high level of readiness.
