



Legal concept of a domain name

Domain name as a contractual relationship?



The legal relationship between the Administrator and the Registrar

Administrator

- Independent and non-profit institution
- Concludes contracts with registrars

Registrar

- Entrepreneur
- Mediates the assignment of "domain names "
- Concludes contracts with users himself (not an agency)
- He has a right to conclude contract with a user, but not an obligation
- Under the Czech law, this contract is most similar to a mandate

The legal relationship between the User and the Registrar

Usually a service interconnected with a web-hosting
The duty of Registrar is to register a domain name at Administrator
User has the right to change a Registrar
Cancelling the contract with registrar, does not mean the
cancellation of a domain name

The relationship between the User and the Administrator

Administrator has a duty to keep the domain name in his DNS database

Innominate contract

Contract for a limited time period

User has a duty to follow the terms and conditions of the domain



TRANSFERING A DOMAIN NAME

Transferring a domain name

Domain name is a contractual relationship between user and sponsoring organization (administrator) of a domain name. The registration of a domain name is usually mediated by "registrars"


Possible transfers of a domain name

Transfer of a domain name between two users


Individual user switches registrars

Transfer of the domain name between two users, new holder transferring a domain name to his registrar

Traditional scheme



User switches registrar



User switches registrar

User gives authorization to a new registrar

New registrar (Gaining registrar) contacts former registrar (Registrar of Record)

Administrator (Registry operator) updates record in the DNS server

The Registrar may deny a transfer request only in case of:

Evidence of fraud

UDRP action

Court order by a court of competent jurisdiction

Reasonable dispute over the identity of the Registered Name Holder

No payment for previous registration period

Express written objection to the transfer from the Transfer Contact

A domain name is in the first 60 days of an initial registration period.


A domain name is 60 days after being transferred

Areas of contract

- Identify parties
 - 1. Must be eligible
- 2. Identify domain name(s) (possible alterations)
- 3. Identify the duty of the seller
 - 1. Give a written request to the registrar/administratior of the domain name
- 4. Idenfy obligations of the buyer
 - 1. Pay the price
 - Information duty etc.

Intellectual property of a website

(Web) Design rights

Problem

Intellectual property is a RIGHT not property

Cannot be "sold" to a third party without the consent of licensor

Even if the seller has all the IP rights, he cannot transfer them - only license

Data protection issues

User databases

Personal data (e-mails, names, familily status) Sensitive personal data

Privacy and personal right issues

Emails, communication records, history of transactions Pictures

Other Issues

In case the site offers service/goods –

Orders
Performance of contracts
Goods "on store"
Logistics (delivery systems)
