03 INFORMATION At approximately 1300 hours, 7/30/ , Suspect/ Nosal

04 contacted Pittsfield Township Police Department after receiving

05 notification of our search from the Dewitt Police Department. Det.

06 Sgt. McReil spoke with Suspect, Nosal and she agreed to

07 immediately respond to PTPD for an interview. On arrival, Suspect/

08 Nosal indicated that she was aware of the allegations against her.

09 She related that Subject/ Keting had contacted her roommate, Jean

10 Ayers and had told her that Victim/ Shoeman was stabbed and had

11 accused Suspect/ Nosal of doing it.

12 INTERVIEW W/SUSPECT NOSAL I, Det. Grimes , conducted the

13 interview with Suspect/ Nosal in the PTPD interview room at

14 approximately 1511 hours, on 7/30/ . Suspect/ Nosal was advised of

15 her rights, per Miranda, and chose to waive them (waver attached).

16 Suspect/ Nosal . denied the allegations made against her and provided

17 the following statement of her activities during the day of 7/30/ .

18 Suspect/ Nosal said she had spent the previous night at home

19 and woke up at approximately 8:00 AM. Suspect/ Nosal , a Michigan

20 State Univ. graduate student in agriculture, stated that, at

21 approximately 8:30 AM, she went to a campus greenhouse for tools and

22 pots. After collecting those items, Suspect/ Nosal indicated that

23 she went to the fields near College Road, Beaumont Road and Jolly Road

24 to collect weed samples for her study. She related that she worked in

25 the fields from 8:30 AM to 9:30 AM, but quit because of bad weather

conditions. Suspect/ Nosal said that, during this time period, she

27 saw no one. Suspect/ Nosal stated that, after quitting work, she
