<p>Blood is a <i>specialised tissue</i> of the body. It is composed of cells that are suspended in a liquid medium. Blood has the schopnost to move throughout the entire body transporting <i>nourishment</i>, water, vitamins, electrolytes, to all its parts. The liquid medium se nazývá plasma and three major blood cells that form a <i>solid portion</i> are red blood cells – erythrocytes, white blood cells – leukocytes, and <i>platelets</i> – thrombocytes. <p>The <i>upper limb</i> is attached to the trunk by the shoulder or pectoral girdle. It consists of the lopatka or scapula, and the collar-bone or clavicle. The <i>collar bone</i> joins the breast-bone. The shoulder girdle is connected to the body by svaly. The bone of the upper arm is called the humerus. The upper end of the <i>humerus</i> has two tuberosities for the připojení of muscles, and a hemispherical smooth head for the shoulder joint. The bones of the <i>forearm</i> are the radius on the thumb side, and the ulna on the malíček side. The humerus and the two bones of the forearm joint at the elbow. The <i>ulna</i> and the radius articulate with the hand in the zápěstí or carpus. The wrist is composed of eight <i>small bones</i> in two rows, from which project the metacarpal bones. <p>The <i>skin</i> consists of two layers: the epidermis, an outer part which is without blood or nerve supply. It is ve stavu of continuous shedding. Cells formed in the innermost part of the epidermis mature and are pushed to the outermost layer. They are sloughed and nahrazovány by new cells. The <i>corium</i> or dermis is situated immediately under the epidermis.
