

# **CONDITIONALS**

## **1st conditional**

*If I fail the exam, I will be sad.*

Form

**IF + present simple, WILL + infinitive**

Meaning

***real and probable situation***

**X**

## **2nd conditional**

*If I won a million crowns, I would travel round the world.*

Form

**IF + past simple, WOULD + infinitive**

Meaning

***unreal and improbable situation***

***Both, first and second conditionals refer to the future.***
