

# CONDITIONALS

## 1st conditional

*If I fail the exam, I will be sad.*

Form

**IF + present simple, WILL + infinitive**

Meaning

***real and probable situation***

**X**

## 2nd conditional

*If I won a million crowns, I would travel round the world.*

Form

**IF + past simple, WOULD + infinitive**

Meaning

***unreal and improbable situation***

**Both, first and second conditionals refer to *the future*.**

## 3rd conditional

*If I had been in the accident, I would have died there.*

Form

**IF + past perfect, WOULD HAVE + past participle**

Meaning

***unreal and improbable situation in the past***

**The third conditional refers to *the past*.**
