Topic to be decided by speakers

Media any media you feel comfortable with

(computer, handouts, board, CDs or any combination)

Speakers

A. prepare questions for your audience - to be asked at the beginning or end

- if asked at the beginning, you will check them at the end, audience makes notes while listening to you
- you may have questions as an emergency instrument in case your colleagues have no questions during or after your talk
- B. to make your talk more interesting (games, crosswords, matching exercises, pictures)

OPTIONAL: prepare for *pre-teaching* terminology/expressions (key words you expect your listeners <u>don't know</u>; expressions and concepts that are <u>difficult to understand</u>)

<u>Audience</u> prepare for asking questions and to discuss ideas

Feedback

Length 30 minutes including discussion

Topic

- an issue important in your Czech classes
- your medical interests
- work experience in hospital/old people's home
- medical topic you enjoy to talk about
- your possible future specialism
