What circulates in the body? - Co cirkuluje v těle?

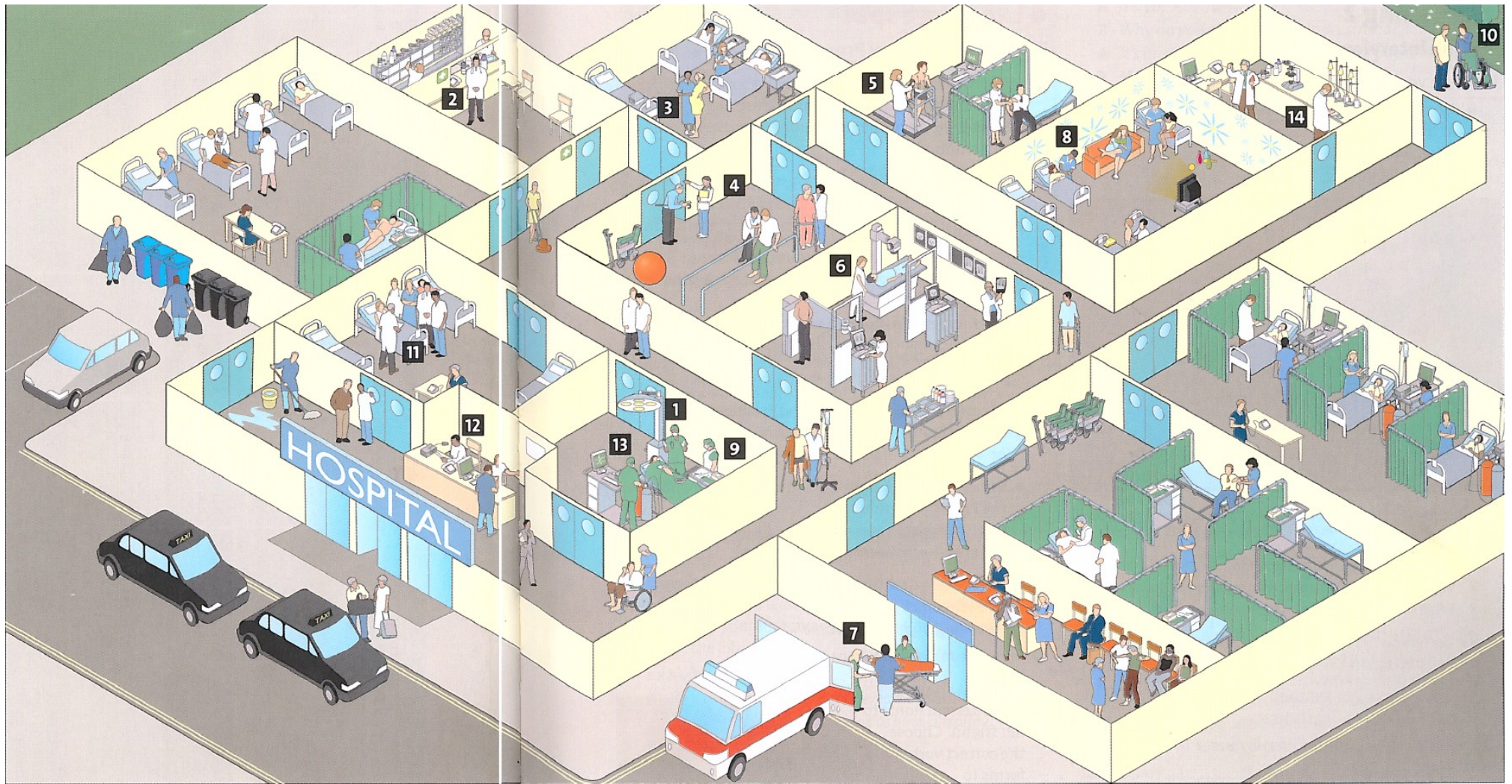
What helps to regulate body temperature? - Co pomáhá regulovat tělesnou teplotu?
