Ex. 1 While dentists concentrate on treating tooth and gum conditions, the dental hygienist (sometimes also known as an oral health practitioner) has a vital role in helping to prevent problems from arising. They clean teeth, examine patients for signs of oral diseases such as gingivitis, and provide other preventive dental care. They also educate patients on ways to improve and maintain good oral health. For example, they may explain the relationship between diet and oral health.

As a dental hygienist you would carry <u>out</u> the following procedures: scaling and polishing teeth, <u>which</u> helps remove tartar, stains, and plaque from teeth, and applying topical fluoride and fissure sealants <u>to</u> protect teeth. If you are based in a hospital, you would also help patients who are <u>having</u> surgery or complicated orthodontic treatment or those with particular medical conditions to maintain a healthy mouth.

This guide explains what happens during a routine dental hygiene <u>check-up/appointment</u>.
