

- Coinfection
  - -severe acute disease
  - -low risk of chronic infection
- Superinfection
  - -usually develop chronic HDV infection
  - -high risk of severe chronic liver disease



# Hepatitis D Virus Modes of Transmission


Percutanous exposures

 Permucosal exposures



Time after Exposure






#### Time after Exposure
