

# 4th declension (u-stems)



- Genitive singular ending: **-us**
- masculines: **-us/-us** example word: *ductus* = duct

	singular	plural
nom.	duct-us	duct-us
gen.	duct-us	duct-uum
acc.	duct-um	duct-us
abl.	duct-u	duct-ibus

One exception of feminine gender!  
*manus, us, f.* -hand

## 4th declension (u-stems)



- Genitive singular ending: **-us**
- neutres: **-u/-us**      example word: *genu* = knee

	singular	plural
nom.	gen-u	gen-ua
gen.	gen-us	gen-uum
acc.	gen-u	gen-ua
abl.	gen-u	gen-ibus

The only other word used in medical terminology declined like *genu* is ***cornu, us* = horn.**

## 5th declension ( $\bar{e}$ -stems)



- Genitive singular ending **-ei**
- Feminine gender, example word: *facies* = face, surface

	singular	plural
nom.	<i>faci-es</i>	<i>faci-es</i>
gen.	<i>faci-ei</i>	<i>faci-erum</i>
acc.	<i>faci-em</i>	<i>faci-es</i>
abl.	<i>faci-e</i>	<i>faci-ebus</i>

One exception of masculine gender!  
*dies, ei, m. - day*

# Decline:



- *genu sinistrum*
- *rabies imminens*
- *lacus lacrimalis*
- *manus fracta*

Rabies = an acute virus disease of the nervous system of mammals that is caused by a rhabdovirus usually transmitted through the bite of a rabid animal and that is characterized typically by increased salivation, abnormal behavior, and eventual paralysis and death when untreated.
